Your Federal Income Tax

NORMAL TAX AND SURTAX RATES

The Internal Revenue Code provides for only one normal tax rate, that is, four per cent of the amount of the net income in excess of the allowable credits such as the personal exemption, credit for dependents, etc.

Following is an example of how to compute the tax on a net income of \$8,500, all of which represents earned net income, the taxpayer being single and without dependents:

Table showing tax calculations: Net income subject to normal tax \$8,500; Less personal exemption \$1,000; Balance (surtax net income) \$7,500; Earned income credit \$850; Total surtax \$6,650.

Investigation of legal phases of the alleged use of forged documents in an attack upon the Dies committee was started today by Rep. Frank B. Keefe (R) Wisconsin.

Aroused by testimony given the Dies committee that forged documents were purchased and used in an attack upon the character of Chairman Martin Dies, Keefe demanded action to prevent a repetition of such an attack.

Keefe's announcement followed examination of testimony taken in secret by the Dies committee, testimony which, he said, revealed that bogus, purchased documents were used in a plot to destroy Dies and his Un-American activities committee.

"I am giving consideration to legal questions," said Keefe. "I believe that there is a very serious question as to whether criminal prosecution would not be justified. I refer to laws regarding acts done affecting congress and Congress less than a month ago enacted a law providing criminal penalties for persons seeking to influence, obstruct or impede" either house of congress or a congressional committee.

LIBERTY CENTER YOUTH KILLED, SIX INJURED IN HEAD-ON COLLISION

A 17-year-old Liberty Center youth was killed and six other persons were injured Friday afternoon when two automobiles collided head-on in Route 68, one mile south of Findlay. The mishap occurred in the same spot where Dr. Roy Offenbater, Bowling Green university president and former Lima superintendent of schools, met death in an accident on Dec. 29, 1938.

The dead youth is Warren Babcock, son of Mr. and Mrs. Rawley Babcock, Liberty Center. Injured were: Merritt Poltz, 29, of Arlington, compound left knee fracture and leg lacerations.

Joseph V. Myers, 42, of Liberty Center, fractured ribs, lacerations of left knee and shoulder injuries. Richard Calkins, 16, Liberty Center, scalp abrasions and facial lacerations.

Franklin Rhodes, 17, Liberty Center, elbow injuries, brush burns on face and left ear hemorrhage.

Donald Myers, 16, Liberty Center, cuts about mouth. With the death of young Babcock and injuries to the six persons, an eagerly anticipated trip to Columbus to compete in the contest of the Future Farmers of America ended.

The collision involved vehicles operated by Joe Myers, going south, and Merritt Poltz, en route north. The five youths were in the Myers auto. State highway patrolmen from the Findlay outpost blamed an icy pavement for the accident.

Babcock died in Findlay hospital a short while after the mishap of a fractured skull. With his third Hancock co. record in his third traffic fatality of the year, Dr. H. O. Crosby, corner reported.

Myers is farm security administrator of Henry-co. Authorities also recalled that a Toledo couple, Mr. and Mrs. Hubert Williams, were injured fatally on Christmas Day, 1938, at the same spot where Babcock met death.

Funeral arrangements for the youth have not been completed. Two auto accidents occurred in Lima Friday but no one was injured.

SEN. GUFFY STAVES OFF EFFORT TO SHELVE HIM

HARRISBURG, Pa., Feb. 3—(AP)—U. S. Senator Joseph P. Guffy, at odds with some Pennsylvania Democratic leaders, today staved off an attempt to pull him on the political shelf, but fell short of obtaining the endorsement of the organization for renomination.

Party heads, anxious to select candidates for U. S. senator, state auditor general and state treasurer, conferred for four hours last night and early this morning without reaching an agreement.

Guffy's wish to retain his seat in the senate, expiring this year, was the center of discussion. Another conference called for today brought the group together in a last-minute "harmony attempt."

Guffy burned the telephone wires thru the day and night in his hotel room, lining up supporters who backed him in his unpopularity from the organization in 1938.

It was that primary fight of two years ago which inspired much of the opposition to Guffy's candidacy now.

Virtually every element of the party was represented in this situation except former Governor George H. Earle, of whom President Roosevelt remarked yesterday he thought there was "something in the works" in regard to his re-election.
