

# Today's Radio Highlights

The sixth annual international day of the International Federation of Business and Professional Women is the occasion for a broadcast bringing together prominent women from all corners of the globe. Lady Cynthia Colville, lady-in-waiting to Dowager Queen Mary, Mme. Joliet Curie, daughter of the famed scientists, and the Marchesa Marconi, widow of the inventor, are among the speakers—WMAL 1:30 p. m.

"Sympathy," from "Firefly," and "L'Amour Toujours L'Amour," both by Rudolph Friml, and Kreisler's "Old Refrain" are sung by Lucille Manners as a part of her concert. Ross Graham is heard in "Every Day Is Ladies Day," from Victor Herbert's "Red Mill," the chorus presents Wagner's "Pilgrim's Chorus," and Dr. Frank Black leads the orchestra in Rimsky-Korsakoff's "Dance of the Clowns"—WRC, 8 p. m.

Among the selections programmed for "Waltz Time" are "South of the Border," sung by Frank Munn; "Long After Midnight," by the Manhattan Chorus, and the orchestra's rendition of "Tres Jolie," by Waldteufel—WRC, 9 p. m.
