Settinus, Knudsen Learn Defies I'll Boss Defense FDR Tells Aide

By T. F. REYNOLDS WASHINGTON (U.P.)—President Roosevelt today led the United States into an era of "emergency management" to rearm itself.

Seven coordinators—members of a civilian national defense commission—were organized and ready to undertake an experiment in democratic shortcuts to apply this country's genius for mass production to fighting planes, heavy guns, tanks, and other instruments of death.

That fact was made clear during the 83-minute initial conference Thursday when Mr. Roosevelt assigned the defense commissioners to their new posts.

After receiving Mr. Roosevelt's assurance he was establishing the defense commission for results, not stage dressings, Knudsen reportedly pledged his cooperation and "signed up for duration."
