LIGHTNING HITS LEIPSIK TWICE

LEIPSIK, July 1—Lightning started two fires during an electrical storm in the Leipscic area last night which caused damage estimated at considerably more than \$1,000, Chief William Jones of the Leipscic volunteer fire department reported today.

About 11 p. m. a bolt struck the barn owned by Ed Montooth in West Leipscic. The building housed several tons of hay which burned so rapidly that the blaze was beyond control before the firemen could reach the scene.

The building was destroyed together with a 1936 automobile, farm trailer and half carload of blacksmith's coal. The hay and coal were the property of Charles A. Hiegle, Leipscic elevator operator.

This fire came just about six months after the Montooth's home was destroyed by fire west of West Leipscic. They purchased the village property in March from H. E. Beach.

The other blaze was at the Townwood home of Harry L. Todd. Lightning struck electric wiring and was carried into the home. Damage was estimated at \$50.

CAMBRIDGE TO FACE BLACKOUT OVER OLD BILL

CAMBRIDGE, O., July 1—(AP)—Dianic steps are being taken by the municipal government here to avoid a financial crisis after defeat of a three mill levy for city purposes at a recent special election.

The city has defied in its current expense fund the principal to electric street light service and the Ohio Power Co. has advised municipal officials that unless his bill of \$17,000 is paid by Aug. 1 power will be shut off until a settlement is made.

Retrenchment in the operating cost of the city have been authorized to solve the financial situation. These include the reduction on pension of Police Chief J. J. Gibson, Lt. Alonzo Baum and Patrolman John Forsythe.

H. W. Watkins has been appointed police chief, Arthur Kimball captain and Harry Carpenter lieutenant. Police department employment will be staggered to reduce expenses. To increase the city's revenue, the water rates will be increased.

FIRE CAUSES \$750 DAMAGE

WATAKONETA, July 1—Fire, caused by a defective flue, caused damage estimated at more than \$750 Sunday morning to the Mrs. Ellen Frego residence, Race-st. Loss was partly covered by insurance.
