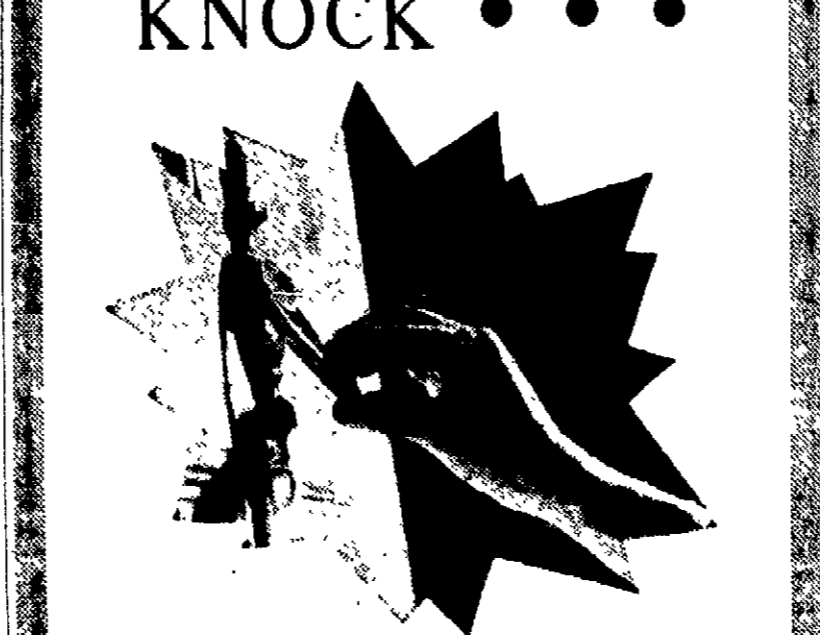

The world's greatest low pressure salesman, Elmer Blurt, will swap advice and reminiscences with the old timer of Rosedale when Al Pearce makes a guest appearance on the Station E-Z-R-A program Saturday at 9 p. m., over WEAFA.

How Elmer Blurt navigated a plane from San Francisco to Hawaii thru 2,400 miles of mist and fog to prepare the way for a regular air service over the same route will be told on Sky Blazers, Saturday, WABC, 7 p. m.

Col. Roscoe Turner, speed ace and master of ceremonies, will tell the story of that historic "first flight" made by Bronte and Ernie Smith in 1926. Despite inclement weather, Bronte successfully charted a course to the tiny group of islands, which were reached in 25 hours and two minutes.
