## Willkie, Army Amateurs, Byrd Salute Top Tonight's Air Shows

Interviews with Wendell L. Willkie's boyhood friends, an army camp amateur show, a movie preview, and Chicago's salute to the Byrd expedition will be among tonight's broadcasts.
