**HONORS ON THE SIDE**  
 CLEAR observers of results know that high honor cards usually are more valuable if they are in side suits than if they are in the suit you bid. They afford you much better defensive values if you wind up playing against the opponents' contract, as they are less likely to be ruffed. They build a better situation for No Trump play if your partner bids the suit that plugs up your weak spot. And they lure many a later double from the defender at your left if your partner supports your suit, the opponent expecting his honors to sit over yours, whereas those held by your partner are over him.

at a log. The double told him to finesse against West for the heart Q and not to finesse the diamonds. West led the spade A, then the 9, and the show was over. Three hearts settled that job. Then four spades furnished discards of three diamonds, and a trump was left in dummy to ruff the last club.

At another table of the same duplicate game, both North and South refused to bid hearts with-out a trick and a half at the top of the suit. So South opened with 1-Diamond. North bid 1-Spade. South 2-No Trumps. North 3-No Trumps, then the Blackwood convention was used as by the heart bidders and the side wound up at 6-No Trumps. West also doubled that, so the hearts again were played right, but the contract was impossible because at No Trumps you can't ruff a club. The diamond finesse had to be tried. It failed and the contract was down.
