FDR, Wilkie, Wallace Highlight Air; Draft Lottery Tuesdaytime

The final week of election campaigning goes under way today and radio tonight will air three of the principal characters, Wilkie, Roosevelt and Wallace, in the 1940 drama. Times and details:
