Streamline glamour is deftly combined with ancient Greek backgrounds in the romantic musical farce, "The Boys From Syracuse," with Rosemary Lane, Irene Hervey, Allan Jones, Martha Raye, Joe Penner, Charles Butterworth and Eric Blom on the cast. "River's End," an epic of the Northwest Mounted Police, is also being shown with Dennis Morgan and George Tobias in leading roles.

Baby carriages have certainly come a long way since 1906 if one judges the two models used in the Republic comedy with music, "Hit Parade of 1941," now at the Quilna theatre. Two models, 1906 and 1941 stand significantly side by side in an old antique trading post, run by Hugh Herbert and his screen son, Kenny Baker. "Model 1906" with a silly fringed parasol overhead stands on spindly shaky wheels, supporting a wooden open-framed chassis, that would be positively no good to baby in cold or drizzly weather. But, ah, 1941! Even an air raid couldn't get into its sleek covered top that rolls back in a convertible coupe effect. Strictly streamlined, it has glass rolling windows on the side, a luggage compartment that opens in the back just like a car, and sturdy balloon tires. And that's not all! If baby decides to grow, another compartment comes out in front and presto the carriage is six inches longer.

In the story someone gives Hugh Herbert the new carriage for one of his antiques. Standing next to its 1906 brother, it is striking to note the contrast in the two models, when we realize that "time marches on," even in baby carriages.

The antique shop is finally traded for a television radio station, and the Republic film, which features Kenny Baker, Frances Langford, Patsy Kelly, Phil Silvers, Mary Boland and Ann Miller, like the 1940 baby carriage, keeps right in step with the swing and the rhythm of the times. It was produced by Sol Siegel and directed by John Auer.

"Hit Parade of 1941" is the second in a series of musical extravaganzas.
