DINING ROOM AT MAY BE HOSTESS OHIO PEN BEING "STREAMLINED"

COLUMBUS, O., Nov. 29-(UP)-Columbus' largest dining room-the hall at Ohio peniten-Tary in which more than 10,000 meals are served daily - is going streamlined.

Following the lead of federal prisons, the Ohio institution is installing cafeterias to replace the old-style restaurant system. At present the system provides facilties for serving one company in this fashion. Frank L. Cheek. prison steward, expects to extend the modernization to serve all inmates by the cafeteria method as soon as six more steam tables are installed,

There are two advantages in the iew feeding systém, Cheek says, First the convicts will be served hot food instead of having to sit down at tables where food had been laid out as much as half an heur previously. And there will he a saving in food, for many prisoners will be able to pass up an article they do not like.
