One of the outstanding musical programs to be heard in the early morning is the Suburban hour (670).

This is a full hour program, on the air every weekend, busy at their tasks of getting ready for the day's work. To be sure, it may not receive the careful attention worthy of it, or the thoughtful listening which is given to the afternoon and evening concerts; but most of our early morning activities are pretty much a matter of routine, so that we can be more attentive to a musical program at this hour than we might at first realize.

The recordings and transcriptions which are played on this program have been made by the leading American and European symphony orchestras, choral groups, and solo artists. The selections are well chosen, and there is very little repetition in the numbers. A nice balance of lighter and heavier compositions is preserved, so that there is entertainment for the entire family.

Wednesday morning, called "Minature Masterpiece Morning," presents a portion, usually one movement, of a symphony or concerto, as part of the hour's program. Saturday morning, called "Musical Masterpiece Morning," is largely devoted to an entire symphony or concerto. Recently the additional numbers have been highlights of the new opera recordings which have been made for music appreciation students. They have been introduced by the announcer in a manner guaranteed to make grand opera much less solemn and much more attractive to the young people, for whom the records are primarily designed.

Of course this is a commercial program, and we must expect advertising and accept it with good grace. The commercials are devoted to travel, an interesting subject to most of us, and are presented as attractively and painlessly as possible by the announcer, Norman Ross, whose pleasing ra-
