'POKER' ROBBERY SUSPECTS WILL FACE CHARGES

WAPAKONETA, Feb. 11—Two brothers, Frank and George Hartbridge, charged with robbery in connection with the \$2,000 "poker" holdup of Albert Gerster, Union-ty farmer, probably will be brought into common pleas court here Wednesday for arraignment before Judge W. T. Copeland.

The arrangements were scheduled for earlier in the week but postponed because of the illness of Prosecutor Paul O. Boesel. George Hartbridge was brought here Saturday from Kansas, City where he was taken into custody by police for FBI men on some other charge. His arrest related to authorities at Kansas City he had failed to appear at an extradition hearing 18 months ago.

Frank Hartbridge has been in the county jail here for almost nine months after having been brought here from Portland, Ore. The brothers have retained George Menahan and Daniel McKeever as their attorneys. Both have been indicted on the robbery count.
