To them comes one of the most tantalizing of all questions: "If every moment might be your last, how would you like each precious second?"

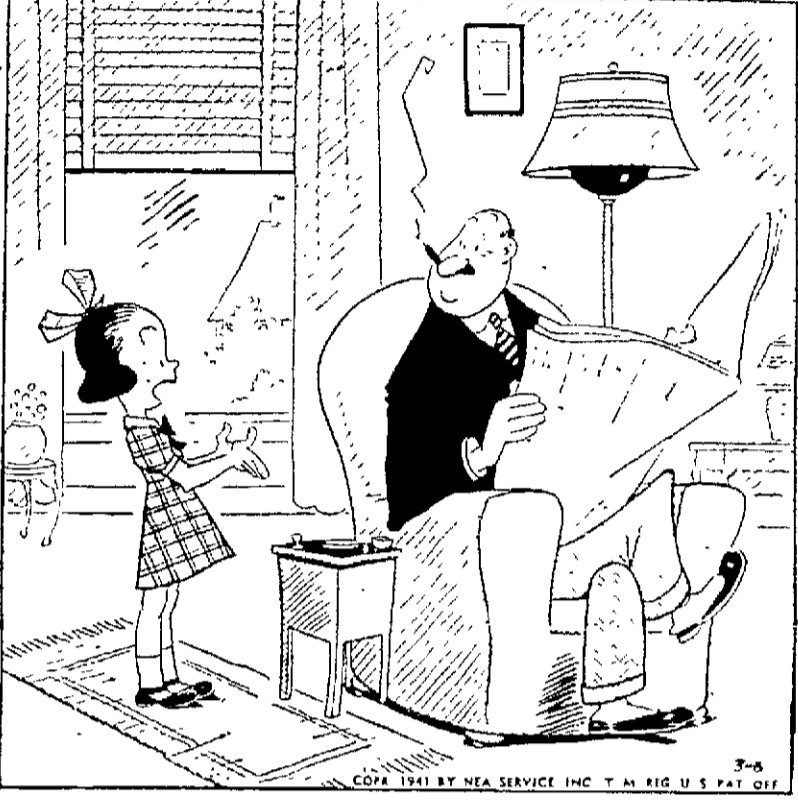

COURT UPHOLDS MAN'S RIGHT TO RUN LUNCHROOM

COLUMBUS, O., March 6 (U.P.)—Sidney A. Miller's right to operate a basement lunch room in the Ohio bureau of unemployment compensation today had the support of the state supreme court.

Miller, a Democrat, indicated he would seek an injunction suit to oust his fourth-floor competitor, Gus Zarnas, former Ohio State all-America football player, a Republican.

Zarnas had the backing of Republican BUC Administrator H. C. Atkinson, who instigated ouster proceedings against Miller. Both the common pleas and appellate courts of Franklin co ruled that Miller's lease, granted by a Democratic administrator, was valid.

The supreme court yesterday refused to review the case.
