Lafayette Farmers to Meet Tonight

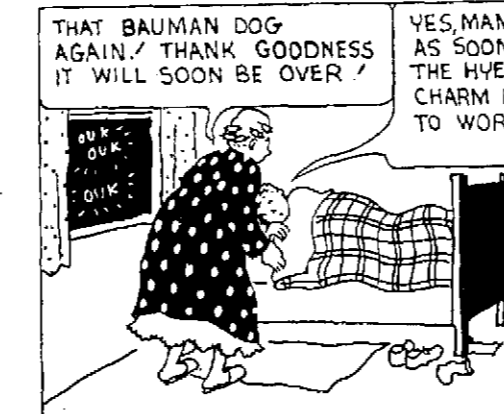
DARLINGTON - Lafayette county farmers will observe the eighth anniversary of the national farm programs at 7:45 tonight in the Darlington high school gymnasium.

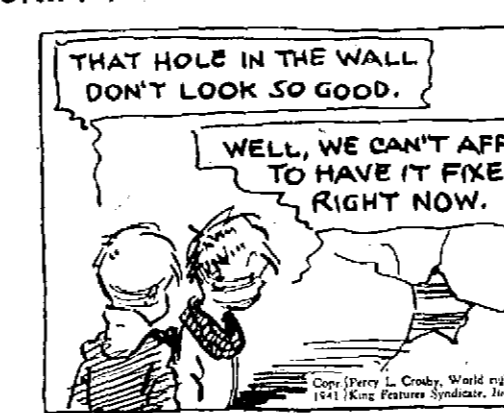
FARM LEADERS MEET MONROE

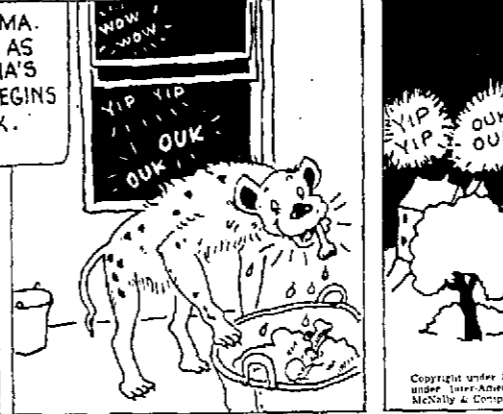

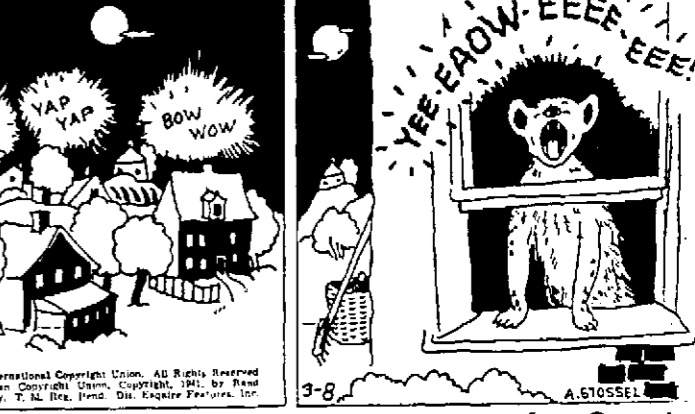
