

# Disney Artists Turning Out Saucy Army Insignia

## Cartoonists Donate Time For Soldiers

### Humorous Sketches Are Turned Out For All Branches Of Service

HOLLYWOOD, March 8—Walt Disney's already busy studio is turning out a batch of extra-curricular work — insignia for the nation's armed forces.

Always eager to display some new saucy insignia, numerous units of the army, navy and air corps have asked Disney caricatures, to be displayed on tanks, cannon, torpedo boats, airplane fuselages and other fighting equipment.

And Disney has consented to donate the time and labor required in designing the humorous sketches. Some of them bear striking resemblance to Donald Duck and to many of the queer-looking spats which recently made their screen debut in "Fantasia."

The first request came from Lieut. E. S. Caldwell of the Naval Operations office in Washington. He said a humorous character was desired to be placed on a new fleet of high-speed mosquito, or torpedo, boats shortly to be commissioned.

Disney went into a huddle with his staff of several hundred artists, and presently they came up with a sketch of speeding torpedo, streaking thru the water, carrying inside it a funny looking, long-legged mosquito. It immediately was adopted as the insignia of the mosquito fleet.

When word got around to other units, it came more requests, and Disney assigned two of his best artists to fill them.

At the request of Fort Richardson's Brig. Gen. S. B. Beckley, members of Alaska's defense forces now are sampling along with the design of a Disney seal, jangling the letters "ADE" on its nose as emblems on the left shoulder of their military coats.

For the mechanized first reconnaissance squadron at Fort Bliss, Tex., Disney provided a sketch of a horse riding in a tank.

For the recently created 15th Reconnaissance squadron of the CHQ air force at Jackson, Miss., the cartoonists designed a four-winged "Woodland" Cafe, hazy, rimmed on a camera, ensconced high in the clouds.

To the 23d Pursuit Squadron in Puerto Rico, went a Disney falcon, fanned and goggled, plummeting earthward in a power drive, wearing boxing gloves on both feet!

The drawing of an eagle, wearing a telescope, with one wing a flutter and signaling, went to the 108th observation squadron in Chicago.

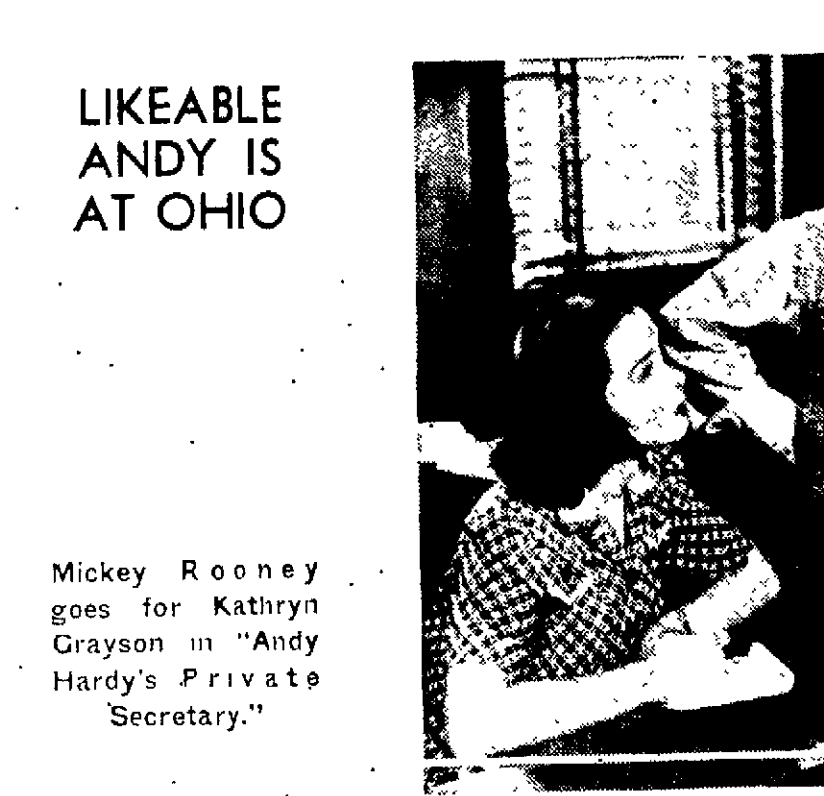
## SOLDIER HAS FURLOUGH

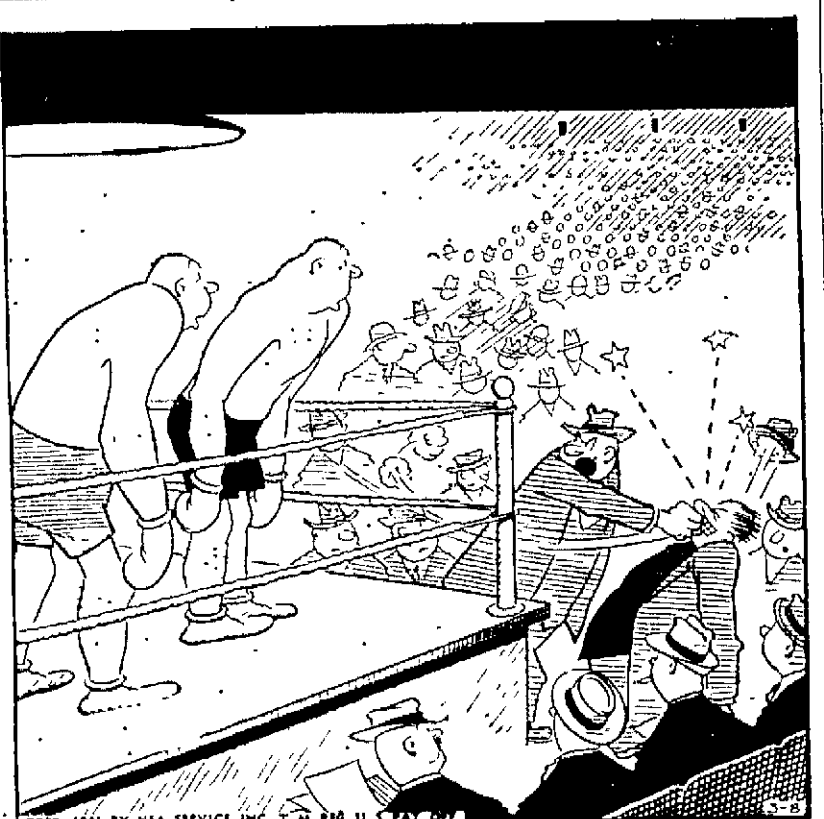

In answer to the inevitable comparison we can say at once that this southern version of "Life With Father" is quite as amusing and as clever as the northern one.

Miss Wylie says frankly that her autobiography is unconventional, and indeed it is. The "George" of the title is her unconscious mind, which in itself is a little unconventional.

## FEDERAL INCOME TAX

No. 17 — Deduction of Capital Losses

No deduction is allowable for losses from sales or exchanges of property, directly or indirectly, between (a) members of a family, (b) a corporation and an individual owning more than 50 per cent of its stock (liquidations, excepted), (c) a grantor and fiduciary of any trust, or (d) a fiduciary and a beneficiary of the same trust.

If (1) shares of stock become worthless during the year, or (2) corporate securities with interest coupons or in registered form are ascertained to be worthless and charged off during the year, and are capital assets, the loss therefrom shall be considered as from the sale or exchange of capital assets as of the last day of such taxable year.

In determining "gain" in case of property acquired before March 1, 1913, the cost, or the fair market value as of March 1, 1913, adjusted as provided in section 113 (b), as amended by section 215 of the Revenue Act of 1939, whichever is greater, should be used, and in determining "loss" the cost, as adjusted, should be used.
