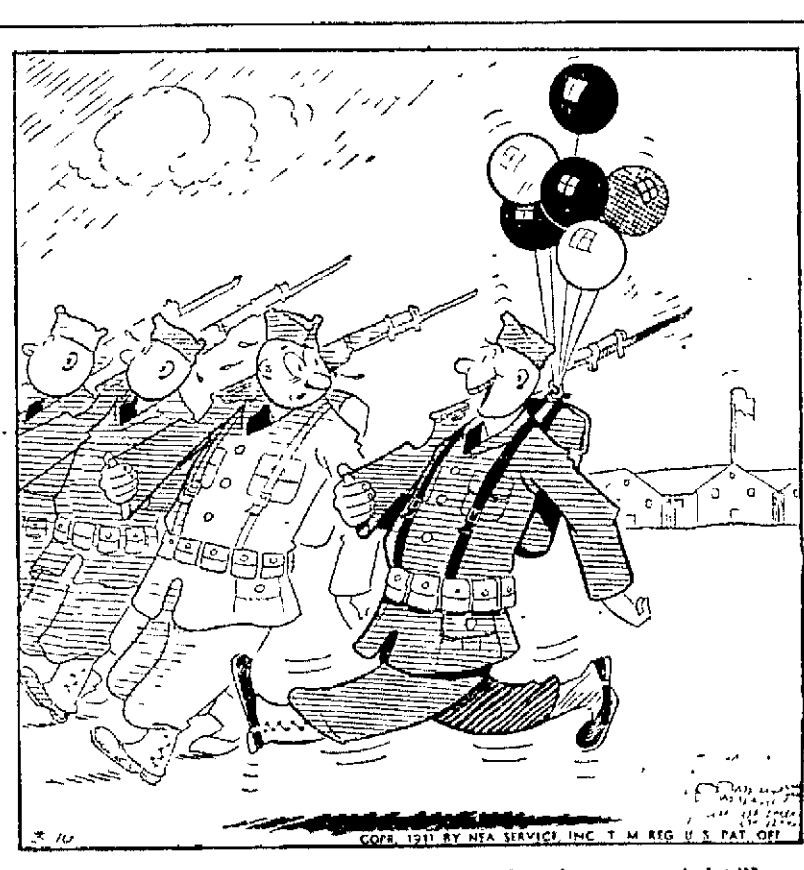

FARM BUREAU IS REORGANIZED

Rutnam-co Group Elects First Officers And Directors In Eight Years

(Lima News Bureau) OTTAWA, March 10—Meeting officers and directors and setting up four major objectives for 1941, the Rutnam-co Farm Bureau was reorganized for the first time in about eight years during a dinner meeting in the Methodist church here last night.

Erna Alston of near Pandora was elected president, William Fanchild of Leipsic vice president and Mrs. David Conn of Leipsic secretary. These three together with the following make up the board of directors:

Mr. and Mrs. Dwight Griffith of Columbus Grove; Mrs. Honor Prowant of Continental; E. D. Grossman of Continental, and Mrs. Arthur Schumacher of near Ottawa.

Objectives include three dinner meetings during the remainder of 1941 with one being held each quarter, the organization of 15 advisory councils, the organization of a Farm Bureau band, and a better and larger campaign in competition with imitations now being sold.

Lewis Washington of the State Farm Bureau Federation led the reorganization. Directors were elected last night when they met and elected the new officers. Then the entire group discussed and set up the objectives.

Further plans for carrying out these objectives will be laid when the board of directors holds its first meeting Monday at 8 p. m. in the home of Mrs. Schumacher southeast of here.

A membership goal of 100 for 1941 was set up by the group. There are about 80 members at present. No further membership campaign is anticipated until next year.

(Lima News Bureau) OTTAWA, March 10—Dr. Glen A. Sheppard of Findlay has moved to Ottawa to take over the practice for the next year of Dr. Walter H. Matuska who has been called from the reserve into active service with the United States army.

Dr. Matuska announced today that he has been notified by war department authorities in Columbus to be prepared for a call to service. He is a captain and expects to be called in about two of three weeks and probably will be stationed at one of the new hospitals being built to serve selectees.

Dr. Sheppard has moved his family into the Matuska home here and will continue Dr. Matuska's office during his absence. He has been a practicing physician for 22 years, 12 of which were spent in New Mexico.

Mrs. Matuska has returned to Detroit and resumed nursing in the Herman Kiefer hospital until her husband is definitely located with the army. Dr. and Mrs. Matuska plan to return here as soon as his military service has been completed, they said.
