

Henry Aldrich Film Stars Jackie Cooper At Sigma

"Life With Henry" Opens With "Remedy For Riches" Wednesday; Majestic Features "Rebecca" Starting Tuesday

Second of the Henry Aldrich films, "Life With Henry" will commence Wednesday at the Sigma theatre with Jackie Cooper in the role of the typical high school lad with the faculty for getting in and out of enormous amounts of trouble.

At the Majestic commencing Tuesday is "Rebecca," starring Lawrence Olivier and Joan Fontaine in the eerie story of the young and unsophisticated girl who becomes the bride of the wealthy and socially prominent Maxim de Winter.

FEDERAL INCOME TAX

YOUR FEDERAL INCOME TAX NO. 19 DEDUCTION FOR BAD DEBTS Rad debts constitute a considerable item in the returns of many taxpayers and may be treated in one of two ways—either by deduction from gross income in respect to debts ascertained to be worthless either in whole or in part and charged off, or by a deduction of a reasonable addition to a reserve for bad debts.

What constitutes a "reasonable addition" to a reserve for bad debts must be determined in the light of the facts, and will vary between classes of business and with conditions of business prosperity. It will depend primarily upon the total amount of debts, outstanding as of the close of the taxable year, those arising currently as well as those arising in prior taxable years, and the total amount of the existing reserve. In case subsequent realizations upon outstanding debts prove to be more or less than estimated at the time of the creation of the existing reserve, the amount of the excess or inadequacy in the existing reserve should be reflected in the determination of the reasonable addition necessary in the taxable year. A taxpayer using the reserve method should show in his return the volume of charge sales (or other business transactions) for half a continent for the ruler who ordered him hanged.
