Chicago Extends Daylight Time Through October

CHICAGO—(U.P.)—Chicago city council Tuesday adopted, 31 to 10, a resolution extending daylight saving time through the last Saturday in October. In the past, daylight saving time has extended from the last Saturday in April through the last Saturday in September.

The council voted, 39 to 1, to circulate petitions calling for a referendum among voters next April on the question of extending daylight saving time through October, 1942. Mayor Edward L. Kelley's administration has assured its support in obtaining the 700,000 signatures needed on the petitions.
