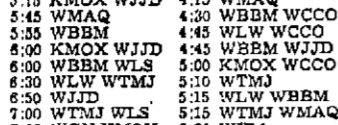

U. of Chicago to Honor Dr. C. E. Allen

A University of Wisconsin botanist who started teaching here 10 years after the University of Chicago was founded today was the winner of a Chicago honorary doctor of science degree.



For his discovery of sex chromosomes in plants, the result of 40 years work, P. O. f. Charles E. Allen was considered by Chicago to be "in the pioneering fringe of advanced learning."

Sex chromosomes are the infinitesimal part of plant's cells which control its inherited characteristics. Knowledge of them forms the basis for many modern theories of sex phenomena.

The botanist's degree will be awarded at a special Sept. 29 convocation celebrating the three-day academic festival observing Chicago's 50th anniversary.

Born in 1872, at Horicon, Ill., Allen was graduated in 1899 from Wisconsin, where he received the Ph. D. degree in 1904. In 1901 he became an instructor in botany at Wisconsin, and in 1909 he was appointed professor. From 1904 to 1905 he was an assistant in the Carnegie institution.

Dr. Allen edited the American Journal of Botany from 1918 to 1926, and served as a member of the National Research Council from 1925 to 1931.

He was president of the Botanical Society of America in 1921, of the Wisconsin Academy of Sciences, Arts, and Letters from 1930 to 1933, and of the Society of Naturalists of the Eastern United States in 1937.

40 Wisconsin Men Study TVA Plant Methods

Forty Wisconsin men—educators, county agricultural agents, and others—will return Saturday from the Tennessee valley, where they are viewing the work of the Tennessee Valley Authority.

The group left here Saturday. Among the men were Prof. C. J. Chapman, of the University of Wisconsin soils department; Forest Turner, university instructor in agronomy; H. H. Hull, university instructor in soils; 17 agents from counties in which experiments in phosphate fertilizer are being conducted; high school agriculture teachers, and county board members.

The trip includes visits to the TVA fertilizer manufacturing plant, experimental stations in Tennessee and Kentucky, and demonstration farms conducted by the TVA.
