Spencer at the Majestic are "Prize of the Navy" and "Dancing on a Dime," while the Radio City "Blazing 10 Days" and "Big Calbre."

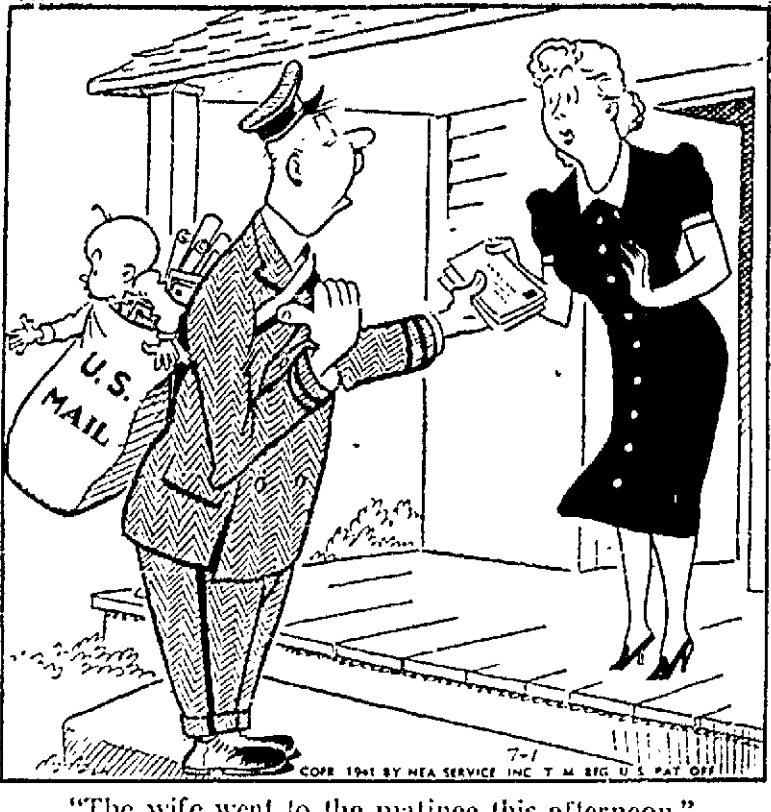
Lauder and romance are the happy combination used in "Affectionately Yours," the new comedy scheduled to open Wednesday at the Sigma theatre.
