WASHINGTON—The army service extension bill is opposed by all the Wisconsin congressional delegation except Rep. Thad Wasieleski, Milwaukee Democrat.

While debate continued over the president's request that congress permit retention of selectees for continued service and remove the present 900,000-men restriction on the number of persons who may be inducted each year, Sen. Robert M. La Follette, Madison Progressive, issued the following statement to his constituents:

"I am vigorously opposed to these proposals. They are a breach of faith, not only with the selectees now in service, but also with the American people who were told by the supporters of the conscription law that it was to provide training to build up a reserve component, and not a law to augment permanently or indefinitely the regular armed forces, nor as a substitute for a regular volunteer army composed of those who choose the army as a professional career."

Wiley Also Opposes Bill Also against the extension bill is Sen. Alexander Wiley, Republican, who said the war situation is "far less critical now from the standpoint of our involvement" because of the Russo-German conflict.

Referring to the "many hundreds of letters" he has received in support of his stand, Wiley asserted that only a negligible number approved the service extension bill.

Perusal of his correspondence shows two central themes. First, a suspicion is expressed that the real purpose behind the legislation is to provide an American expeditionary force; second, a general resentment is noted that men should be kept in service when they entered believing they would serve one year, even though the selective service act specified they were subject to longer service upon action by congress.
