

"Adventure In Washington" Opens At Quilna On Friday

Robert Marshall Cast As A Senator With Lovely Virginia Bruce In Leading Feminine Role

As a U. S. senator, Robert Marshall comes to the Quilna screen Friday evening starred with Virginia Bruce in "Adventure in Washington," a tale of intrigue and scandal in the world's mightiest capital. Young Gene Reynolds heads the featured cast, with Samuel S. Hinds and Ralph Morgan also appearing as senators. Co-featured will be "The Lone Wolf Takes A Chance," starring Warren William. Concluding films are "Dance Hall" and "The Bride Wore Crutches."

The Ohio theatre offers "The Shepherd of the Hills," a tale of loves and hates struck from the primitive passions of the hill people, with John Wayne, Betty Field and Harry Carey cast in the lead roles. Other performers include Boulah Bondi, James Barton, Samuel S. Hinds, Marjorie Main and Ward Bond in the picturization of the novel by Harold Bell Wright.

"That Uncertain Feeling" is the title of the laugh-provoker at the Sigma theatre with Melvyn Douglas, Merle Oberon and Burgess Meredith in the lead roles. Miss Oberon and Douglas portray a young American couple who have money but lead rather simple lives until a psychoanalyst, the part portrayed by Meredith, complicates things for them. Co-featured is "I'll Wait For You."

The difficult feat of bringing a stage play, set in almost its entirety in one setting, has been done in a masterly manner in "The Last Mile," the current Lyric feature starring Preston Foster and Howard Phillips. The story is a powerful tragedy of condemned men within the walls of a prison death-house. Tim McCoy, rough riding Robin Hood of the range, is the star of the co-feature, "Fighting Renegade."

The story of a man who tried to withdraw from the world, on an island near Java, and a woman who restored his faith in mankind thru the power of love, forms the basis of "Victory," current State feature which offers Fredric March in the role of a cynical recluse and Betty Field as the woman. Rudy Vallee and Helen Parrish are the principal performers of "Too Many Blondes," also showing.

Majestic theatre films are "Land of Liberty" and "Give Us Wings." The film concerns itself primarily with three individuals... a young senator whose importance to the nation almost causes him to lose sight of the personal equation, which means so much to human relationships, a lovely blonde reporter whose determination to "get that story" keeps her constantly "in the hair" of the junior senator from New York, and a youthful east side hoodlum who is appointed to the senate page boy staff, where he discovers that friends are more powerful than fists.

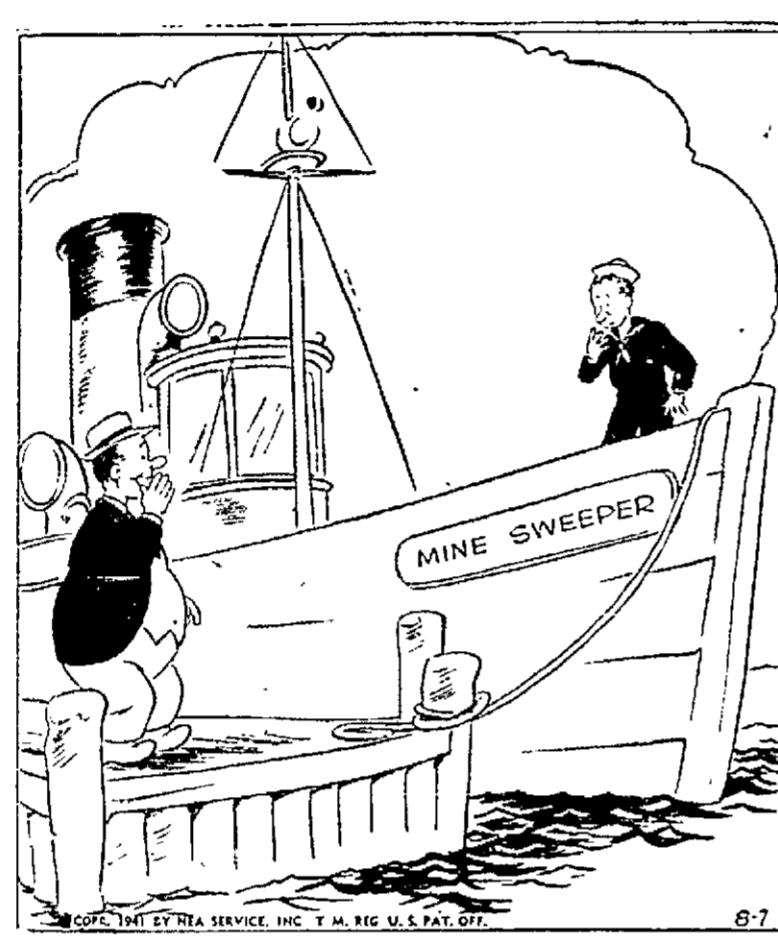
