### MANY BRITISH WOMEN REFUSE TO REGISTER UNDER SERVICE PROGRAM

LONDON, Aug. 15.—(INS) — Thousands of young women between the ages of twenty and twenty-one have failed to register in Great Britain under the National Service Plan.

These women, it was learned, had no excuse for not registering, but when questioned they were able to state their objections, if any, to the interviewing officer. If these objections were satisfactory, he saw to it that they would not be called upon to help in the making or handling of munitions.

They will be offered work wholly connected with the maintenance of essential civilian services, like the handling of food rationing, or looking after small children.

LIABLE TO JAIL TERM If a woman is a conscientious objector and refuses to do any work when directed by a National Service officer, she will be guilty of an offence under the Defense Regulations, and will be liable to a \$400 fine or three months in jail.

Every woman who is called upon will have the opportunity to explain her domestic circumstances. If she is running or helping to run a household, she will not be asked to partake in the scheme.

### BRITISH SET SHIP SALVAGE AT 100 MILLION SAVING

LONDON, Aug. 15.—(UP) — Ships and cargoes valued at nearly \$100,000,000 have been recovered by the Salvage Service since the beginning of the war. The total represents a high percentage of all sinkings which salvage officers have been able to reach.

About \$45,000,000 represents food, munitions, metals and other pre-war value of ships sunk or damaged by enemy action.

Results so far obtained are due to great advances made in the design and handling of special pneumatic tools invented since the war began.

### PLANT CONTRACT LET BY COMPANY

(Special To The Lima News) ST. MARYS, AUG. 15.—The St. Marys Manufacturing Co. has let a contract for the construction of a plant for the production of phosphoric acid.

The estimated cost of the building and the equipment amounts to about \$100,000, according to reports. When the addition is completed it will have relatively little effect on the number of employees the company employs since the manufacture of phosphoric acid is largely a chemical engineering operation.
