Ship Arming Doesn't Mean War, Sen. George Says

WASHINGTON (U.P.)—Sen. Walter F. George (D., Ga.) called for passage of neutrality act revision in a nationally broadcast speech Sunday. He contended that arming of ships and sending them into belligerent zones "are not such acts as will necessarily take us into war," but warned that "defeat of the pending measure "may bring us nearer to war." George recalled the successful 1917 senate filibuster against Woodrow Wilson's armed ship bill and said that action supplied Germany with "the necessary evidence of disunity in America... and we were brought nearer to the war." Similar refusal by congress to give President Roosevelt the power requested in the pending bill "may again evidence a spirit of disunity in America... and bring us nearer to war," George warned.

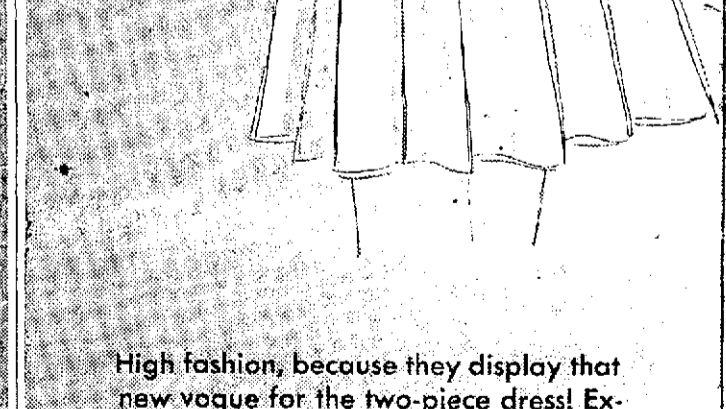


Britain Sinks Many U. Boats, LONDON (U.P.)—The destruction of many German submarines during the past few months was claimed today by First Lord of the Admiralty Albert V. Alexander in a speech at Dewsbury, Yorkshire. He said German attacks at sea increased after the German invasion of Russia. Alexander said that despite German acceleration of naval warfare "the grand work of the navy with minesweepers and convoy escort ships, has kept down losses." "Many U-boats have been seen destroyed," he said.
