NEW YORK—(U.P.)—When "Sleepy Jim" Crowley cautioned last week that Fordham faced a stiff test in Pitt, the wags compared his remark with the famous headline: "Stagg Fears Purdue."

What happened in murky Pitt stadium last Saturday sobered the gentry and all listened attentively Monday when Crowley explained the why and wherefore of the Rams' dumping by the purified, pulverized Panthers.

"It isn't easy to say," he said sadly, "But Pittsburgh outplayed us all the 60 minutes. I had told everyone that Pitt was coming along fast and our boys knew it. They weren't over-confident and they didn't lay down for a minute. It was just that Pitt didn't let up for a minute."
