



WASHINGTON, Dec. 3—(AP)—The Justice department has announced today that FBI agents seized 30 men in Detroit, Chicago and New York in connection with stolen auto parts alleged to have taken millions of dollars worth of materials from the Ford Motor Co.

J. Edgar Hoover, director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, said that the total value of parts stolen from Ford plants had not been determined, but that information now available indicated that the ring in operations thus far in 1911 had netted "at least \$1,000,000" and that the figure might "run as high as \$3,000,000 or \$4,000,000."
