WASHINGTON, Dec. 8-(INS) -The United States treasury, in pointing out that the "trading a with the enemy act" had been clamped down against Japan, today warned all firms and individuals in the United States not to trade with any Japanese nationals or companies in this or any other country, including Latin and South American republics.

It also ordered banks not to allow any withdrawals in any amounts whatsoever by Japanese, nor any withdrawals to be sent to American citizens in Japan. The treasury ordered all Japanese banks in this country to cease business. Further, treasury officials warned American banks not to let Nippon nationals visit any safety deposit vaults or boxes.

The trading with the army act provides a penalty of a \$10,000 fine and long jail terms, or both, for having anything to do with
