Heick Heirs Lose on One Question

Heirs to the estate of Mrs. Louise Heick, who died a year ago, lost on one of two questions answered by County Judge Fred M. Evans in a decision today.

ONE. Should Mrs. Heick's estate share in sales (of real estate) after her death? Judge Evans ruled that it could not.

TWO. Should her estate share in any further payment on a \$25,264 note held by the trustee of the estate of Charles W. Dohelin, a brother, who died Dec. 27, 1930?

Mrs. Heick was bequeathed five twenty-fourths of a \$100,247 trust fund. The total Dohelin estate amounted to \$208,791. The trust fund is shared by eight others.

The note was for \$13,125 but accrued interest increased it to \$25,264. Judge Evans said Mrs. Heick's estate might share in the accrued interest of \$12,139 but not in interest which accrued since Mrs. Heick's death.

"The estate's right to share in income stopped at Mrs. Heick's death," he said.

Enlistees! Apply for Birth Records Two Weeks Ahead

Wisconsin men who plan to enlist in the armed services should apply for a certified copy of birth certificate about two weeks in advance of their visit to the recruiting station, according to Francis E. Koster, head of the bureau of vital statistics, state board of health.

Still swamped by national defense demands for proof of citizenship, the state bureau may need that much notice to provide a certified copy, Koster advised.

Men residing in the county of their birth may get quicker action by applying to the county register of deeds, he pointed out, and the branch state offices, one at 2425 Atwood ave., Madison, and the other at 1547 No. 14 st., Milwaukee, will aid prospective soldiers, sailors and marines in procuring the needed certificate.

Barclay on Bridge: BEWARE OF THAT REBID! SUPPOSE you are playing with a very fine partner. If he bids "one more than necessary"...

South's double, for fancy reasons, did not work. It fooled North into thinking he could beat 4-Hearts, whereas it was made, plus an extra, with the loss of one trick in spades and one in diamonds.

At No. 2, South's simple overall made it easy for West to make a free bid of 2-Hearts, so that East and West reached a game bid. South, overcalling this at 4-Spades, was set one trick, losing two in hearts, one in diamonds and one in clubs.

At No. 3, South's winning bid of 2-Spades was too high for West to overcall with 3-Hearts, so he passed. North, properly treating this as probably showing a two-suiter, strained to keep it open, with 2-No Trumps. When South then bid 3-Spades, North knew the jump overall had been on a considerable suit, but not much else.

Your Week-End Lesson: If you and your partner show a powerful two-suiter over a hostile opening call by bidding "one more than necessary" in one of your suits, as an almost absolute one-time force, so that on the next turn the other suit can be disclosed, what kind of hands should you proclaim when you make an infomark, a set, a takeout double?
