College football is not a new experience to George Murphy, popular young star of Mark Hellinger's "Rise and Shine," the current film at the Quilna theatre.

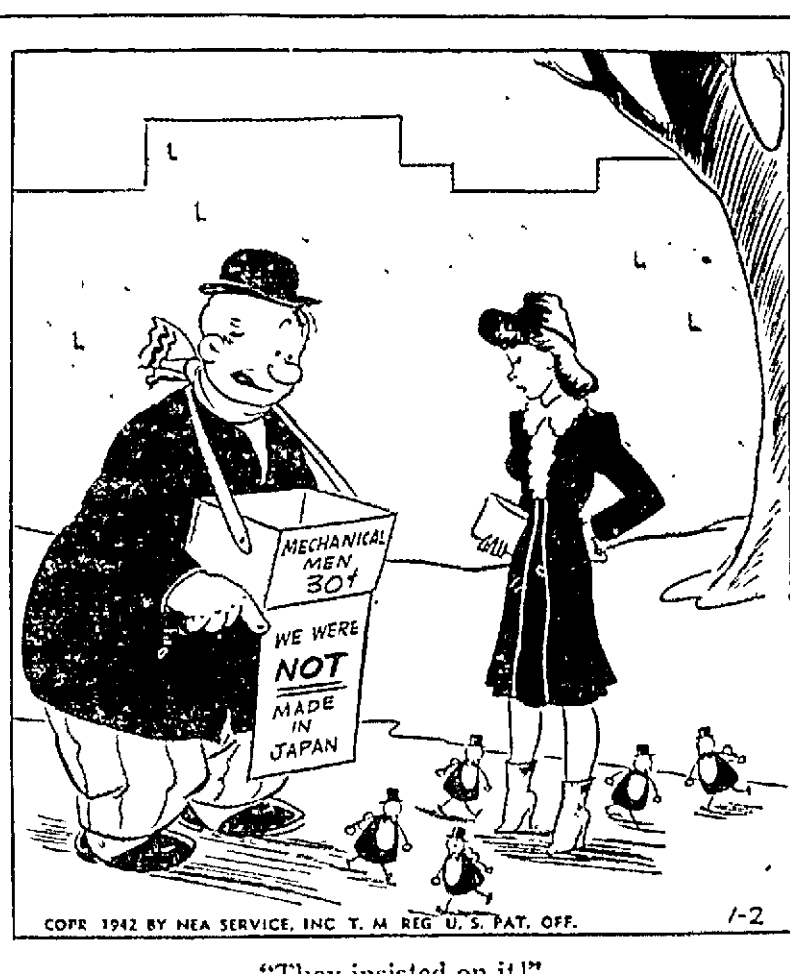

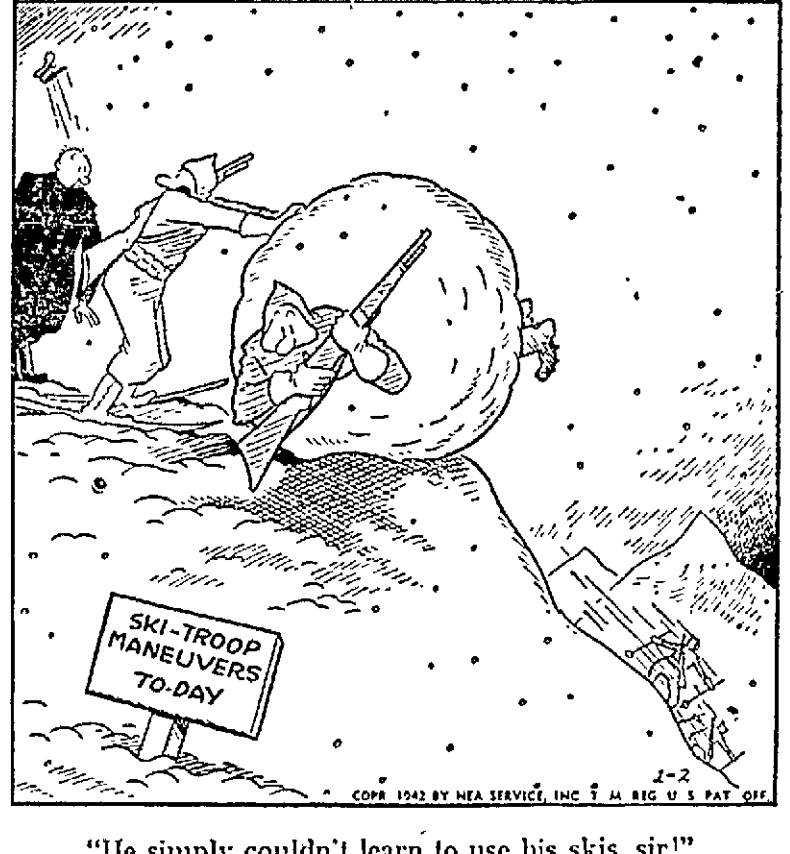
