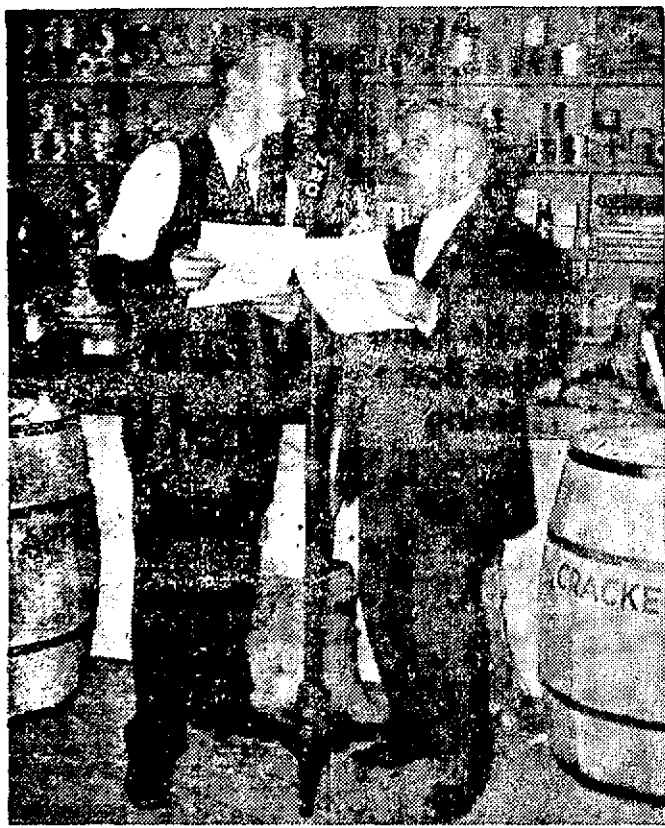


Lum and Abner in Business
