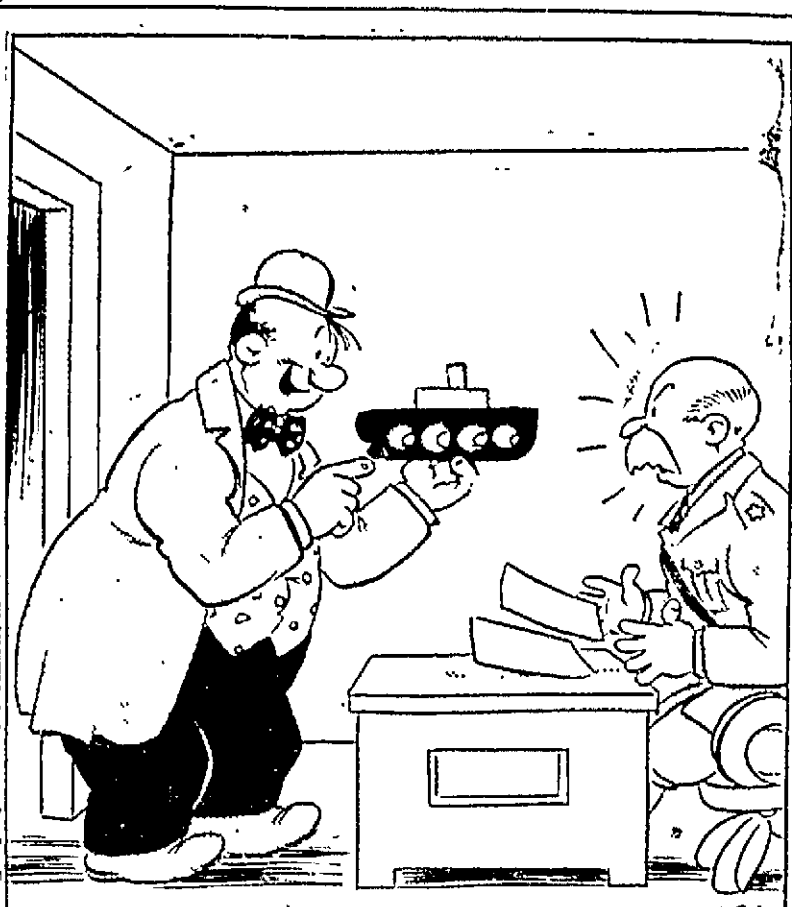

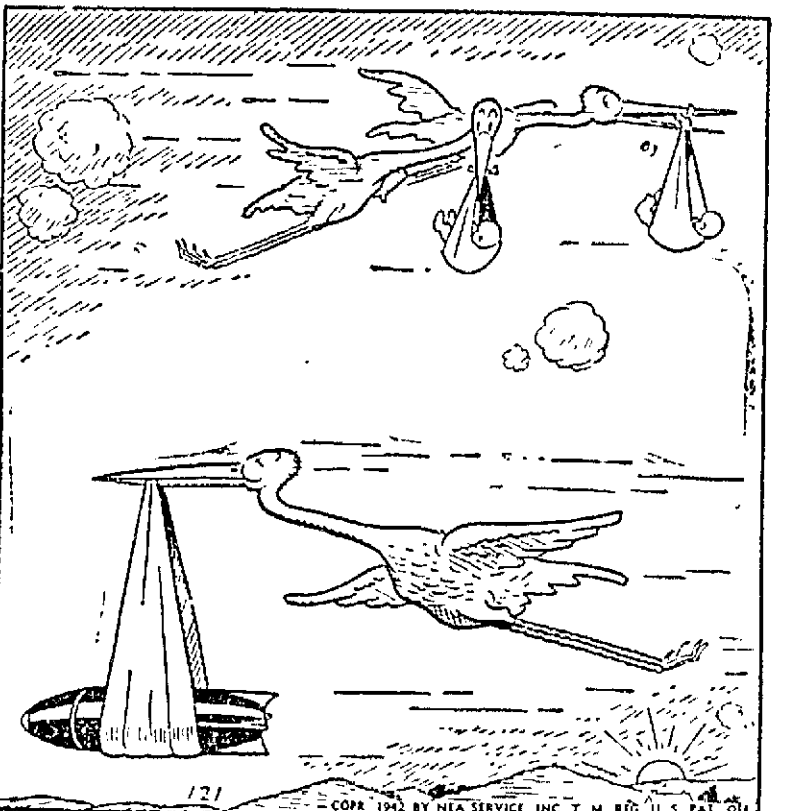

mentor had written: "Perhaps the most significant single factor in 'Texas' is that it moves. It moves fast. You'll remember how Marshall put the 'Daltons' together so tight and smooth that someone had his gun out every other minute and in between he was teaching for it or putting it away. There's this kind of pace in 'Texas'. The minute the customer sits down in his seat, he's off!"

Alma Kruger, after finishing work in "Sing For Your Supper," with Charles Buddy Rogers, also at the Quilna theatre, spent most of her time getting in shape for the Pacific Southwest Tennis Championships.

The erstwhile famous model, turned actress, comes from an outstanding tennis family. Her mother was women's singles champion of Brazil. Her brother Bob is the present Junior National Singles titleholder. Her other brother, Charles, who is too old for junior competi-

tion, is regarded by sports writers as a distinct threat in the men's singles for 1942 or 1943.

Jinx Falkenburg comes out with the most radical and probably most daring innovation in hair-dress in this picture. It is best described as the "half and half"; that is, half blonde and half brunette.

"The idea is not as crazy as it sounds. Its reason is photogenic, to give Jinx's hair a permanent highlight. While the bulk of her hair is dark, she has bleached part of it touching her forehead and added slight blonde streaks in other places, giving the effect of light and shade and a softness that is usually obtained by top and back lighting.

These Kildare dramas are always so expertly cast that one cannot find a flaw in any of the performances, but a word must be said for the skillful work of Walter Kingsford, Nell Craig, Edward Gargan, Marie Blake, Frank Orth, George H. Reed, and Barry Nelson, another newcomer to the series, who gives a compelling portrait of a delirious tremens patient who runs amuck in the hospital.

When Hollywood has a hit on its hands, it promptly tries to make another of the same type. Generally, things do not work out that way. . . . it takes a long time before another "Thin Man" comes along, or a second "It Happened One Night."

On the other hand, when George Marshall makes a picture like "When the Daltons Ride," he promptly followed it with another, and even more sensational success, "Destry Rides Again." These films out of the way, Marshall rolled up his sleeves and made "Texas," his greatest Western action hit to date. The film, now at the Quilna theatre with William Holden, Claire Trevor and Glenn Ford, packs more roistering excitement than both its predecessors together.
