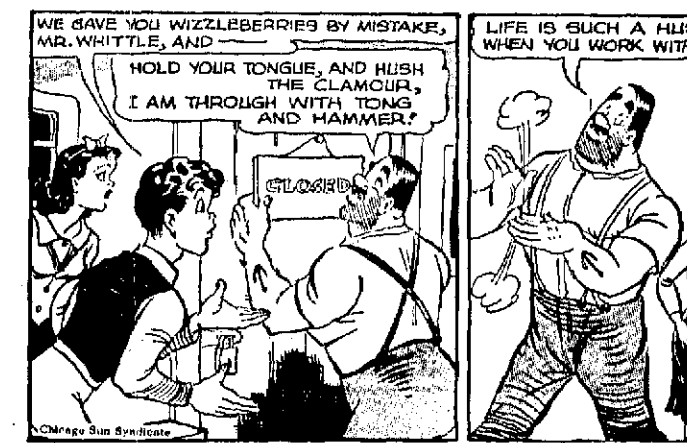

SAN FRANCISCO (U.P.)—More than 75 members of an alleged Italian Fascist society have been seized in the government roundup of enemy aliens suspected of subversive activity, the Federal Bureau of Investigation disclosed Tuesday.

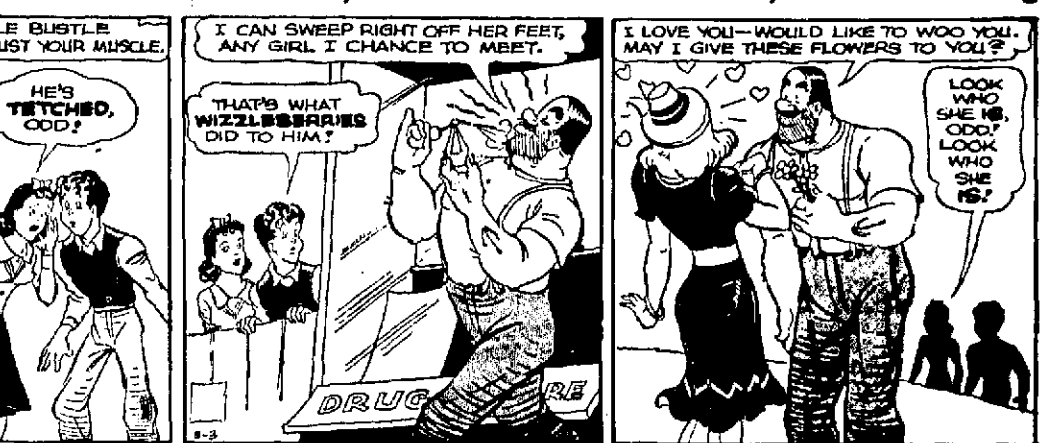
