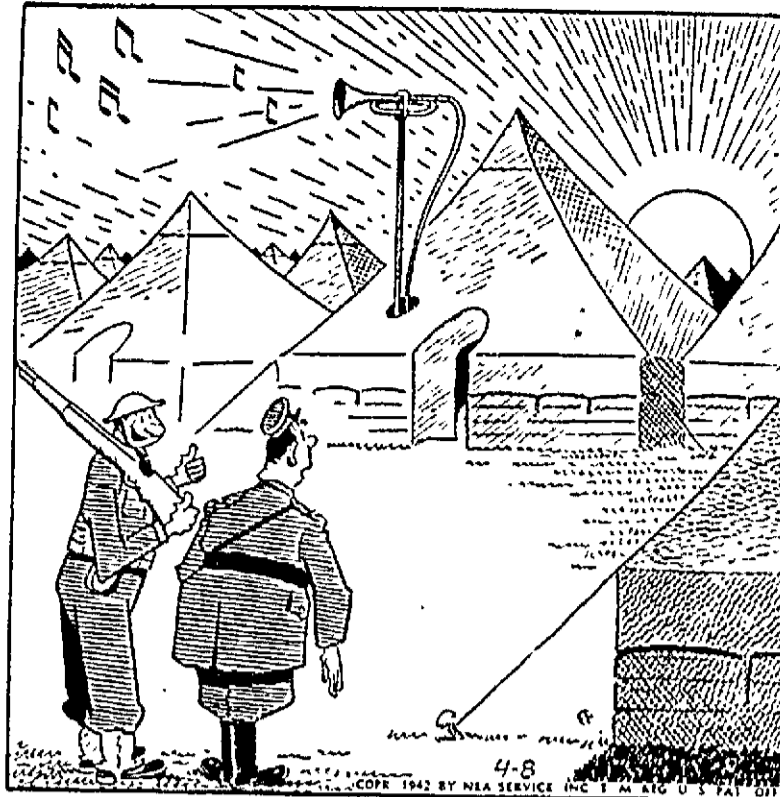

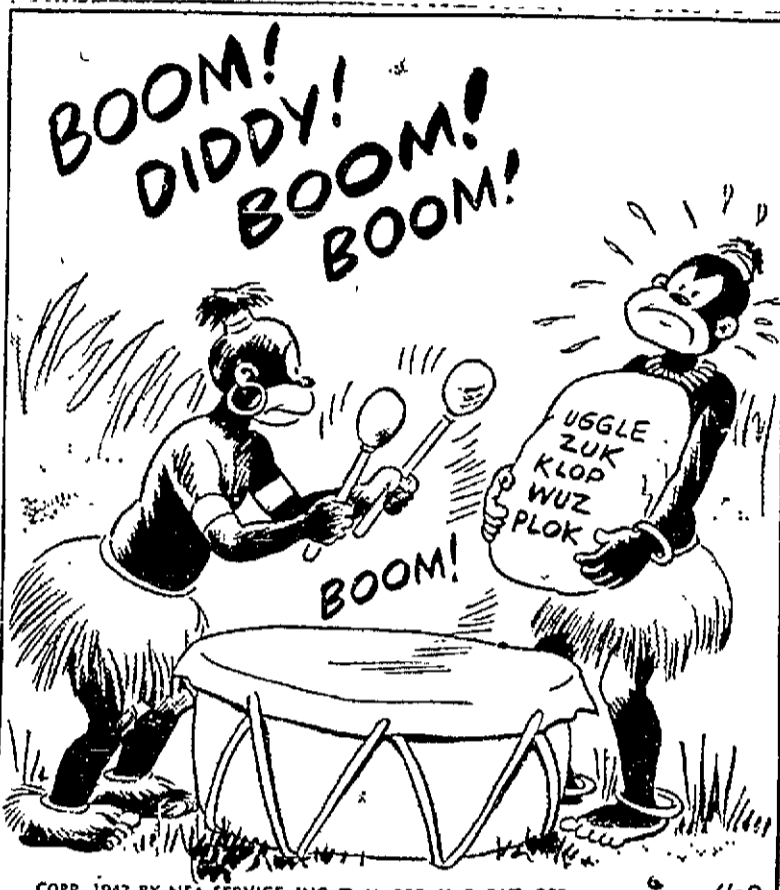

Low Ayres On State Screen In Latest Kildare Picture

"Skylark" To Be Second Film On Double Bill; Betty Grable And Vic Mature Co-Starred In Quilna Feature

That conscientious objector now very much in the "public eye" will be viewable Thursday at the State theatre when that film with the very significant title, "Dr. Kildare's Victory" is scheduled to be shown. It is one of the peak roles in the medico series of "Dr. Kildare's" as interpreted by the limelighted Low Ayres.

"Skylark" will be the companion-piece on the double bill. Meanwhile at the State "The Man Who Came to Dinner," this column's personal nomination for the top-drawer film of the year, and "Design for Scandal" are presented for the last times Wednesday. Colorful in background and exceedingly scenic as regards the grass skirt gyrations of blonde Betty Grable is "Song of the Islands" currently at the Quilna theatre. That glossy long haired Victor Mature, plays opposite in Grable, Jack Oakie as a Texas cowpuncher goes Hawaiian in no minor way. The first days showing of two real whoop-it-up action thrillers is now in effect at the Sigma theatre. "Bullet Scars" and "Come On Danger" are the twin offerings jammed with that type of activity that keeps the patrons perched on the rim of the seats. "Freckles," that lovable character from the story books, makes an appearance in "Freckles Comes Home" projected now at the Lyric theatre. For those who have read the printed tale of Freckles this film will be as big a treat as for those who meet the sun-flecked face of our small town hero for

the first time on the screen. "Heart of the Rio Grande" also shows. Exceedingly popular as a best seller and doubly so as an excellent dish of cinema fare is "King's Row" now shown at the Ohio theatre. The story concerns the progress of a small town physician and what happens to his friends. Some of the more "difficult" angles from the book are skilfully handled. Ann Sheridan, Robert Cummings and Ronald Reagan are listed among the star studded cast. LYRIC
All the enchantment of the Painted Desert region at sundown has been recaptured by Republic Pictures in their latest Gene Autry musical western, "Heart of the Rio Grande," which made an impressive hit with yesterday's opening day audiences at the Lyric theatre.
