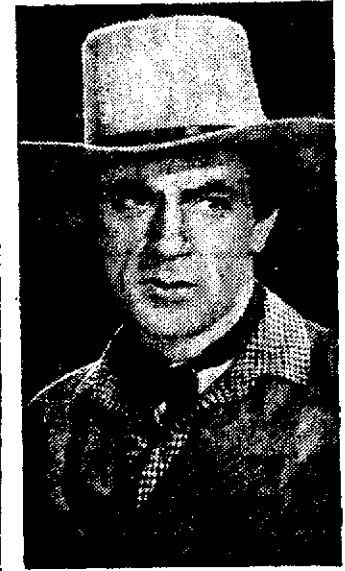

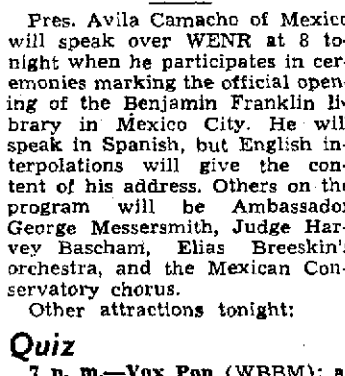

300 Receive 'T. B.' Tests at Monroe

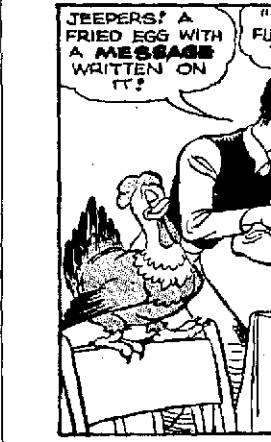
