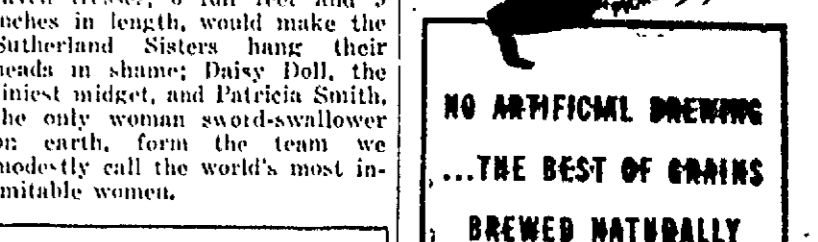


RECIPE
Baked Ham and Potato Baskets
1/2 ham (6-8 pounds)
1 cup brown sugar
1 tablespoon bread crumbs
Whole clove
6 sweet potatoes
1 cup crushed pineapple
DIRECTIONS: Preheat roaster to 450° F. Score ham and put ham in uncovered dish, rub fat side with 1 cup brown sugar and 1 tablespoon bread crumbs.
Potato Baskets
Peel large potatoes. Cut into strips 1 inch wide 1/2 inches long. Cut very, very thin. Cut one end to a point. Place 7 potato around a small noodle basket. Hold securely and fry in deep fat until tender. Fasten and place in a temperature of 350° golden brown in a temperature of 350°. Fill baskets with cooked peas and garnish with parsley.

FACTS about NUTRITION
1. Use a minimum of water in cooking all foods.
2. Cook foods as short a time as possible.
3. Bring to the boiling point as rapidly as possible.
4. Cook with slow, gentle heat.
5. Use utensils with tight-fitting lids.
