Captain Floyd J. Sweet of the Air Corps Training Department for Gliders will be the sole guest on Bing Crosby's Music Hall Thursday at 9 p. m. over WEA and will explain as much as he can, without revealing military secrets, about the glider pilot, training program of the U.
