

Relief Cases Drop in State

Winter Season Shows First Decrease

This year, for the first time since records have been kept, the winter season showed a decrease in the number of Wisconsin relief cases, the state department of public assistance reported Saturday. The March, 1942, case total was the lowest since August, 1934. The total number of public as sistance cases last month was 98. 278, a drop of nearly 2 per cent from the February figure and more than 24 per cent from the total of a

All categories of public assistance showed slight decreases from February, 1942, figures and all save old age assistance dropped considerably from the March, 1941, level. Old age aid showed a 1.2 per cent increase. Largest decreases in the past year have been in general relief, down 40.9 per cent and WPA, down 50.6 per cent. General relief also showed the largest decline in the past month, falling off to 23,277 cases, a drop of 4.1 per cent.






