Milwaukee Wins Takes Half a Game Association Lead

(By United Press) The Milwaukee Brewers held a one-half game lead in the tight American Association pennant race today.

The Brewers broke a first place tie with Kansas City by defeating Toledo, 6-4, Wednesday while the Blues were idle. Milwaukee pounded Harry Kimberlin for one run in the first inning and four more in the second before Fred Sanford came in to halt the uprising. The defeat dropped Toledo from third to fourth place behind the idle Louisville Colonels.

In the only other game sched-

uled, Minneapolis climbed into seventh place and shoved its Twin City rival, St. Paul, into the league cellar by coming from behind to win a 13-12 slugfest.
