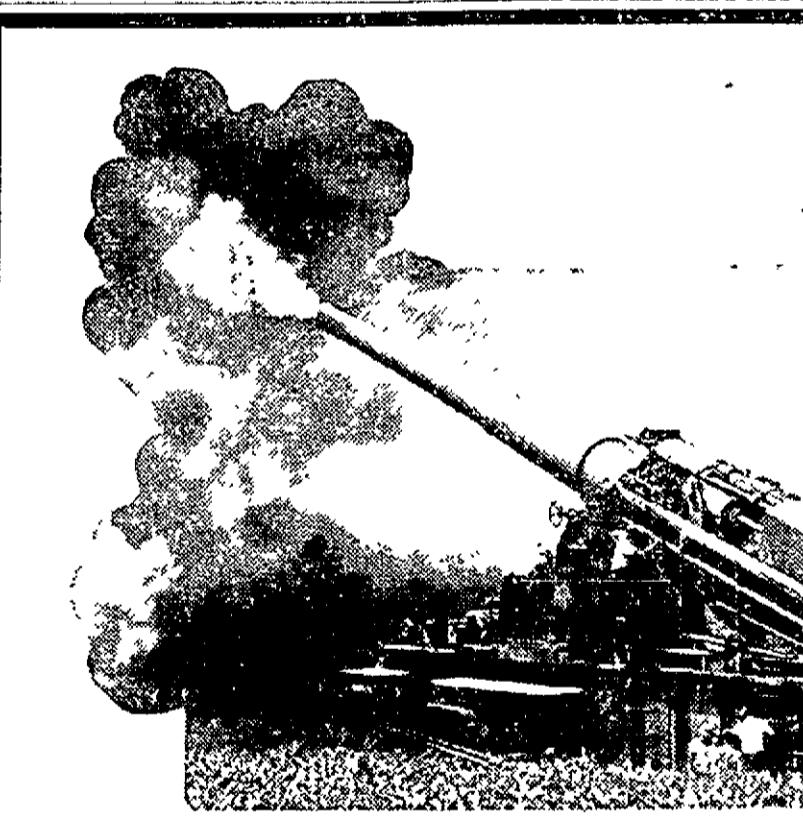

The story of a strange, fascinating hero of adventure is contained in "Jungle Book," the technicolor film now at the Ohio theatre. Sabu has the leading role as the youth Mowgli, reared by beasts of the jungle, while others in the cast are Joseph Calleia, John Qualen, Rosemary DeCamp and Patricia O'Rourke.

The stars of "Cadet Girl," the current Lyric film, are John Landis, George Montgomery, John Shepperd and William Tracy, unfolding the story of a West Point cadet's sweetheart. Second feature at the Lyric is "Man at Large," a timely story that might well have been taken from today's headlines.

The problem of a career woman is given refreshing treatment in the new film, "Woman of the Year," now at the State theatre, with Spencer Tracy and Katharine Hepburn in their first appearance together on the screen.

In a story packed with thrills, unexpected twists and potential dynamite, lovely Marjorie Weaver is cast as a news reporter. Assigned to get a statement from an escaped German ace, she unknowingly stumbles into an F. B. I. counter plot.

Puzzled by the behavior of Investigator George Reeves, she innocently lends the aid of the fifth column's head. How she gets out of the fix makes for top-notch entertainment.

Preview audiences have hailed "Man at Large" as an exciting story of the F. B. I.'s activities in a fight against spies in this country that might be going on now.

The featured cast of "Man at Large" also includes Richard Derr, Steve Geray and Milton Parsons.

A gay and refreshing stimulant for war-shattered nerves, Republic's "Sleepytime Gal," starring Judy Canova, is now at the Quilna theatre.

Miss Canova's comedy is irresistible; she could extract laughs from the sourest of misanthropes or the gloomiest of neurotics. And as for the average, normal and intelligent movie-goers—she slays 'em!

It is a part of the Canova formula—used successfully in such pictures as "Scatterbrain,"

"Sis Hopkins" and "Puddin'head," to place Judy in a position in which she is pathetic as well as ludicrous. Thus, she has the same wistful appeal which made Charley Chaplin one of the most famous comedians of all time.

The ambitious bell hop (played engagingly by Tom Brown) has large ambitions due to his love for the news-stand girl (Mildred Coles). He cannot marry because of his low financial status, but by making Judy a spectacular radio star, he will be in a position to achieve his heart's desire.

So Judy, the unpretentious, ambitious cook's assistant, is heartlessly glamorized and flung into the position of radio contest winner, with the glaring publicity spotlight focused directly on her winsome but ungainly self.
