

Bela Lugosi Has Lead Role In Thriller Due At Lyric

"Black Dragons" Is Title Of Highly Absorbing Story; "Broadway Big Shot" Is Second Feature On Bill

Bela Lugosi is the star, and his sinister personality is ideally suited to his role, in "Black Dragons," a thrilling and highly absorbing story commencing Tuesday at the Lyric theatre.

"Hellzapoppin'," modestly described as a smash-bang, eye-filling, tune-filled show of New York stage fame, is now offered as screen entertainment at the State theatre, with its original stars, Oleson and Johnson, plus Martha Raye, Hugh Herbert, Mischa Auer, Jane Frazee and Robert Paige.

Nazi spies lead Bob Hope and Madeleine Carroll a merry chase in the latest fun film at the Ohio theatre, "My Favorite Blonde." Hope has the role of a ham vaudeville who, with Percy, a performing pequin, gets mixed up in secret intrigue, thanks to Miss Carroll, a beautiful British agent.

Edward G. Robinson heads the cast of the comedy, "Larceny, Inc.," which holds sway at the Sigma theatre. Aiding in the comedy are Jane Wyman and Brod Crawford. Hit number two at the theatre is "True to the Army," starring Judy Canova, Allen Jones and Jerry Colonna.

Headed by Laurence Olivier, Leslie Howard and Raymond Massey, with Anton Walbrook, Eric Portman and Miss Glynis Johns featured, a cast of thousands bring to the Quilna theatre screen the year's most sensational adventure film, "The Invaders."

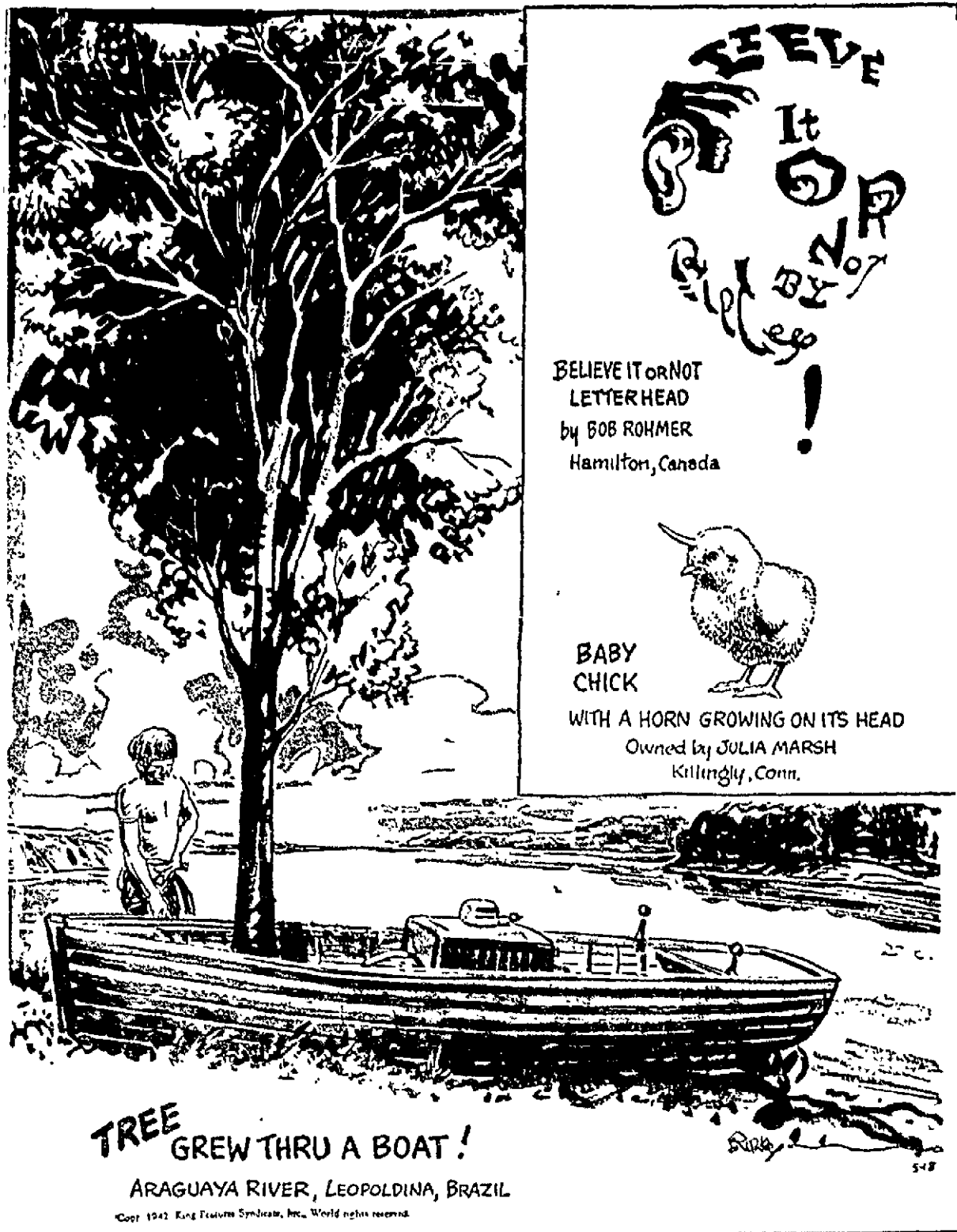
Pointing up the calm, grim determination of a nation roused into fighting fury by the terrorism and arrogance of a small band of Nazis, stranded in Canada when their submarine is blasted out of the water by the Royal Canadian Air Force, "The Invaders" packs within its breathless unrelenting thrills of a lifetime, the heroic gallantry of simple democratic folk, the thundering impact of a desperate man-hunt which covered a continent.

Olivier is seen as an exuberant French-Canadian trapper who believes the war is far away and none of his business; the stranded Nazis shatter that illusion with dramatic sharpness. Howard appears as a dilettante who tries to escape from the world by retiring to an idyllic mountain fastness; the fleeing U-boat man blunder into his luxurious retreat, fear at his "decadent" philosophy.

The year's strangest film drama is "Black Dragons," the picture which comes to the Lyric theatre on Tuesday with Bela Lugosi in the starring role.

The story, weirdly horrifying in its implications, concerns the less-than-human machinations of the Black Dragons, deadly secret society of Japan. Lugosi, a plastic surgeon, is sent by the Nazis to the oriental capital, where he transforms six Japanese into living likenesses of a like

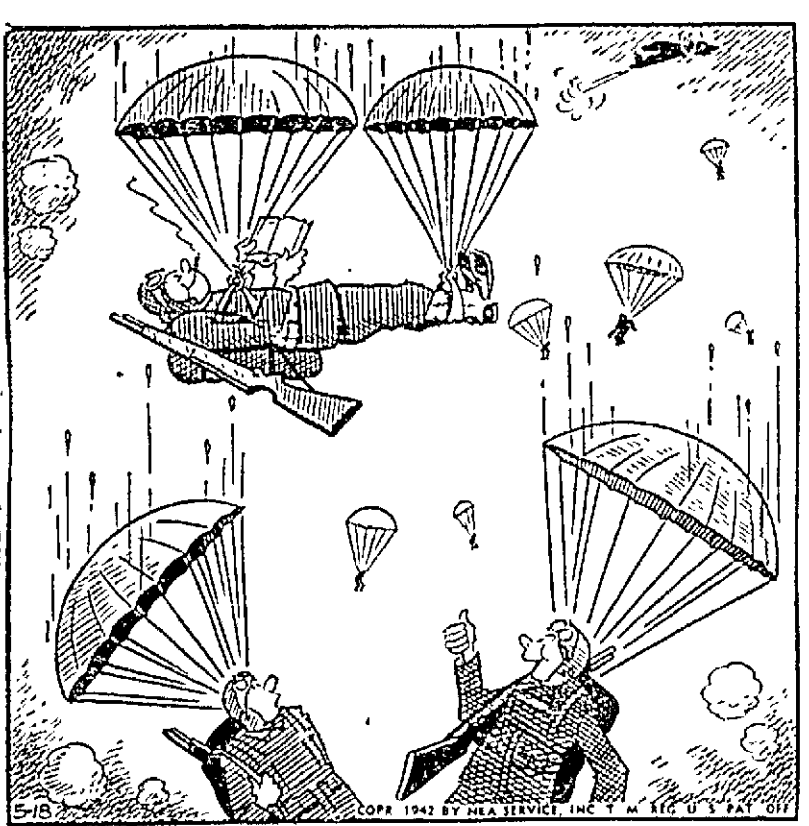

RATIONING OF LIVING SPACE

CLEVELAND, May 18—(AP)—Possible rationing of housing to assure war production workers living quarters was forecast today by Paul A. Porter, deputy administrator of the OPA in charge of rent control, in an address before the Mortgage Bankers Association of America.

"A ceiling on rents doesn't put a roof over a worker's head and as rubber wears thin and production expands, we shall have to give serious consideration to the necessity of using all available living space," Porter said.
