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Willkie, Dewey Well Matched

Gallup Poll Shows 48-52 Division

PRINCETON, N. J.—The political split between Wendell Willkie and Thomas E. Dewey is being watched by political observers as a preliminary round for the 1944 presidential fight. The disagreement between the two men came to a head this week when, with Dewey a leading Republican candidate for governor of New York, Willkie pointedly suggested that the New York GOP should not overlook Rep. James Wadsworth as a gubernatorial candidate. The Willkie-Dewey closeness has broad implications for the Republican party throughout the nation. The chief question is whether the rank and file of GOP voters would side with Willkie or with Dewey if these two most popular men in the party should come to a showdown over the 1944 presidential nomination. Well Matched A poll just completed by the Institute among Republicans throughout the country, that is, persons who voted for Willkie in 1940, shows that the two men are almost evenly matched in popularity, with a small majority in favor of Willkie. The rank and file attitude was sounded on the following question: "If it came to a choice between Willkie and Dewey for Republican candidate for president in 1944, which man would you prefer?" Among those with opinions on the subject—and only one in every six were undecided—the vote is as follows:
VOTE OF REPUBLICANS
Willkie ..... 52%
Dewey ..... 48%
