

WIBA Broadcast Will Tell How Copper Helps Win War

How copper plays its part in a world in total war will be told in Three-Thirds of the Nation, to be broadcast over WIBA at 9 tonight. In "Copper, the War's Messenger Boy," the program will tell how the makers of cartridges and bombsights, the infantryman and the bombardier, and the sacrificing civilian can work together to defeat the Axis.
