# NAVAL HERO ON VISIT TO HOME

OTTAWA, June 26—In a few days Milo Persinger, 21, will return to active duty as an aviation mechanic, second class, in the United States Navy after spending a furlough with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Alfred Persinger, who lives west of here near Cloverdale.

Persinger was reticent about his many close escapes from death but consented to talk briefly about his experience of surviving the sinking of the aircraft carrier Lexington which was sunk in the Coral Sea.

Unlike many of his comrades, Persinger did not leave the damaged ship by sliding down a rope into the churning water. He said that he made a running dive into the water so he could get as far away from the ship as possible to avoid being pulled under by the strong undercurrent near the ship.

Further conversation with the youth revealed that when he found an injured man in the water, Persinger took off his life jacket and placed it on his fellow-sailor. After that heroic act, the young man had to paddle about in the water for an hour and 45 minutes awaiting rescue.

# PLANE TRAINING TO BE OFFERED IN HARDIN-CO

(Lima News Bureau) KENTON, June 26—Pre-flight training will be offered high school junior and senior boys in all of the Hardin-co school districts beginning next fall. Officials of the county school system are making preliminary arrangements for the inauguration of the plan at the request of the federal and state governments. It was considered possible that youths who are out of school might be enrolled in the course, providing their credits make them eligible.

For a student to qualify for the course, he must have at least two years of mathematics and a year of physics. The latter may be taken in conjunction with the course. It was suggested that one and possibly two teachers will be employed by the county board of education to teach the course evenings in all schools in the system.

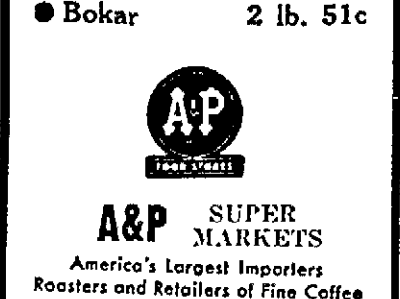

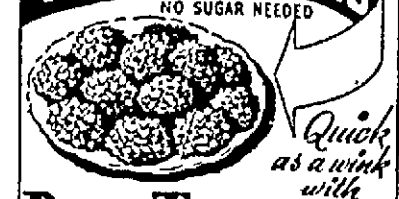
