Getto Named Dodgers Coach

NEW YORK—(U.P.)—Mike Getto, former All-America tackle at the University of Pittsburgh, began his gridiron career at Jeanette, Pa., high school and played under Sutherland at Pitt in 1926-27-28. He was a member of the undefeated 1927 team which went to the Rose Bowl and was named an All-American the following year.

After graduation, Getto was line coach at the University of Kansas until he became an aide to Sutherland on the Dodgers' staff in 1940.
