"Above Suspicion" and "Assignment in Brittany" are two books that put young Authoress Helen MacInnes in the fourth guest expert spot on "Information Please" for Friday, at 8:30 p. m., over WEA-F, Clifton Fadiman, presiding.

So Kieran, Adams and Levant will thus be joined by the lady whom critics call the most likely author to take the place in letters left vacant by John Buchan's death, or the one deserted by James Hilton when he went to Hollywood.

Miss MacInnes, Glasgow-born and Glasgow-University-educated, has published both her best sellers during the past two years.

They are novels of adventure and mystery, with European backgrounds that could only be written by one who knows the locale and understands the people.

St. John's college, Oxford, Miss MacInnes and her husband traveled widely, during their long vacations, in Bavaria, France, Belgium, Northern Italy, Spain and the Tyrol. In 1937, the Highets came to America where Gilbert joined

the faculty of Columbia university, from which he is now on leave for war work.

A cold-blooded murderer's strange penchant for nursery rhymes and an eight-year-old girl's singing of the quaint verses make up the central theme of the "Gang Busters" dramatization.
