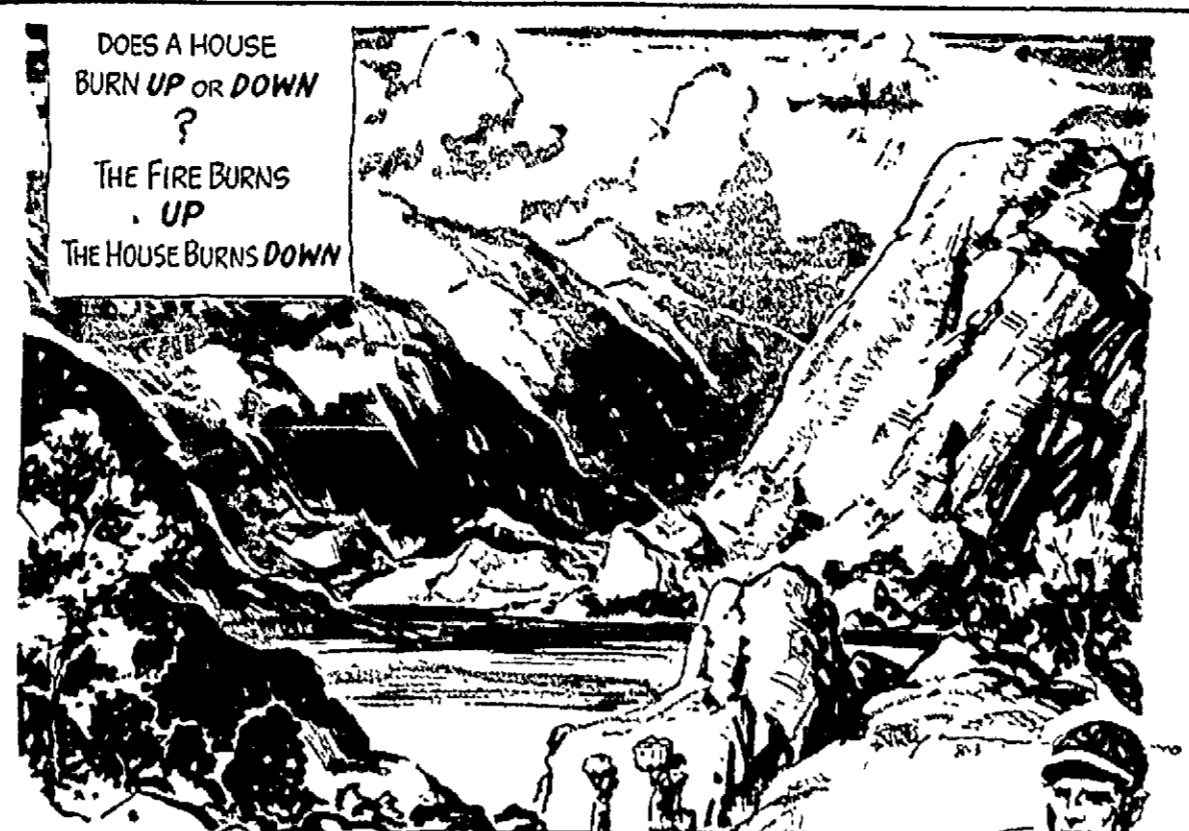
in the featured roles. Rollicking comedy characterizes the story and the picture is filled with hilarious incidents.

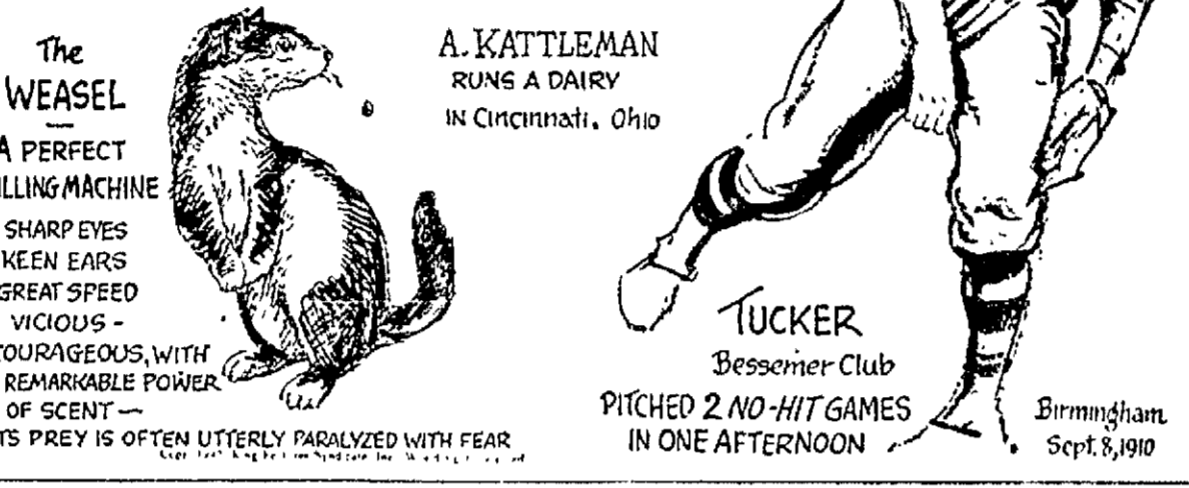
