




#### PERU HONORS ORELLANA'S "Cap'n, I wants to get my rep- CONQUEST OF THE AMAZON

LIMA, Aug. 20—(UP)—In the early months of 1942 the Peruvian government will celebrate the 400th anniversary of the first voyage by a white man down the Amazon river.
