Thrifty Outfit Spends \$20, Downs Zeros

AN ADVANCED ALLIED BASE, New Guinea.—(U.P.)—Maj. Lester Henderson wants the United States taxpayers to know that his anti-aircraft outfit is economical. It spent only about \$20 worth of ammunition in destroying one and possibly two Japanese Zero planes the last time it went into action. The incident occurred when a damaged Flying Fortress was trailed by the three Japanese fighters. The American pilot led the enemy over the concealed ack-ack guns and then left the rest to the ground forces. The first Zero was hit and shot down. The second was hit and disappeared with smoke pouring from it. Possibly it crashed. The third fled for home. "It was all over in about 2 minutes," Henderson said. "We fired only about 250 rounds." Henderson said most of the credit for the accurate shooting should go to men from South Carolina and Georgia because many of the officers and men in the platoons charged with spotting enemy planes are from those states. The outfit has had experience in 62 air raids without suffering a single casualty. Henderson believes this represents more action than any other United States ack-ack battery in the southwest Pacific has had. "However, I'm afraid we frightened the Japs away with that little show the other day," he said. "At least, if they don't drop around often my men are liable to get soft."

SUN PRAIRIE.—Mr. and Mrs. August Holtscher have been notified by the British Broadcasting Co. that their son, Rodney, radio engineer in a royal air force station somewhere in England, will broadcast on the American Eagle club program to be carried by station WGN at 10:30 a. m. Sunday. Eire has agreed to ship 100 tons of dressed beef, equivalent to about 600 head of cattle, to England every week.

Judge Applies War Time to Liquor Sale

OCONOMOWOC.—(U.P.)—Municipal Judge Alvin G. Brendemeuhl Thursday made the first ruling in Wisconsin that war time applies to liquor sales made after 1 a. m. Judge Brendemeuhl fined Louis Herro, bartender, \$50 for selling liquor after hours and granted the defendant a one week stay to decide whether to appeal the decision. Defense contended that the sale occurred at 12:05 a. m., central standard time, whereas Oconomowoc police who made the arrest claimed the sale took place at 1:05 a. m., war time. In the decision the jurist stated that "Wisconsin time is based on central standard time, as defined by the statute of the United States," must rule that on a federal change in the definition of central standard time, the state statute by
