"The Gay Sisters" Continues At Ohio And Sigma Brings "The Road To Happiness" To Limaland

Bad men will bite the dust in droves come Thursday at the Lyric theatre when two semi-stupendous sensations are screened. Unleashed in all their rip-snortin' magnitudeness will be "Texas Justice" and "Hillbilly Blitzkrieg." Both are guaranteed to make the back hair bristle on all western drama lovers.

In the interim the Lyric will present "Son of Fury" and "Blue, White and Perfect."

Barbara Stanwyck, Geraldine Fitzgerald and George Brent shoulder honors in the Ohio theatre's currently professed production "The Gay Sisters." A new screen player, Gig Young, a gent who received his photo name from a horse and wagon set, also makes his debut.

Eleanor Powell as a gal with a tommy gun tapping feet, goes thru some new routines in the film "Ship Ahoy" showing for the last time Wednesday at the State theatre. To add to the overall enjoyment of this feature is Tommy Dorsey's band. "A Gentleman After Dark" is the alternate attraction.

Brand new at the Sigma is "The Road to Happiness" that opens Wednesday at the Sigma theatre. Music plus adventure makes a perfect fanfare combination in this one. The "plus" picture at the Sigma is "Prisoner of Japan" starring Alan Baxter and Gertrude Michael.

THE musical of the year is "Footlight Serenade" now at the Quilna theatre. Some of the zippiest tunes of the day are whipped out and plugged by the delectable Betty Grable. An excellent cast also includes the utterly handsome Victor Mature and he-man John Payne.

"Here's the lowdown," the burly scrapper explained. "Vic and I rehearsed the bout very carefully. Being a pro, I knew what I was doing; but Vic, who isn't a bad mitter — for an actor — gets excited in the heat of the battle. Then, just when the script calls for me to roll with one of his left jabs, he forgets what he's doing and conks me with a stiff right. "Did it hurt? Well — all I gotta say is that Vic weighs 220 pounds and he's built like one of those heavy tanks. That's all, brother!"
