BOARD UPHOLDS BAN ON TIRES FOR SPEEDERS

CLEVELAND, O., Oct. 9.—The legal division of the Regional Office of Price Administration today ruled that local war price and rationing boards could legally deny new tires, grade II tires and recaps, to applicants otherwise eligible, but who had been proven to have driven their cars faster than 35 miles per hour.

Birkett L. Williams, regional OPA Administrator, sent copies of the opinion to all local rationing boards in his five-state region of Ohio, West Virginia, Kentucky, Indiana and Michigan.

The legal opinion, written by C. F. Taplin, Jr., regional rationing attorney, held that the withholding of tires for abusive driving was a matter of local board discretion. He held that emergency speeding in the transport of injured persons to hospitals as an example, might well be deemed not an abuse of tires.

HONORS GIVEN TO 2 MARINES

SAN DIEGO, Calif., Oct. 9.—(INS)—Heroism medals were awarded two marines who rescued a marine sergeant from the wreckage of a burning plane near Santee last April, the Eleventh Naval district reported today.

The two are Sergeant Norman C. S. Pearson, 21, of Minneapolis, and Corp. Gordon Miller, 20, of Cincinnati. In addition to the medals, they received citations from President Roosevelt.

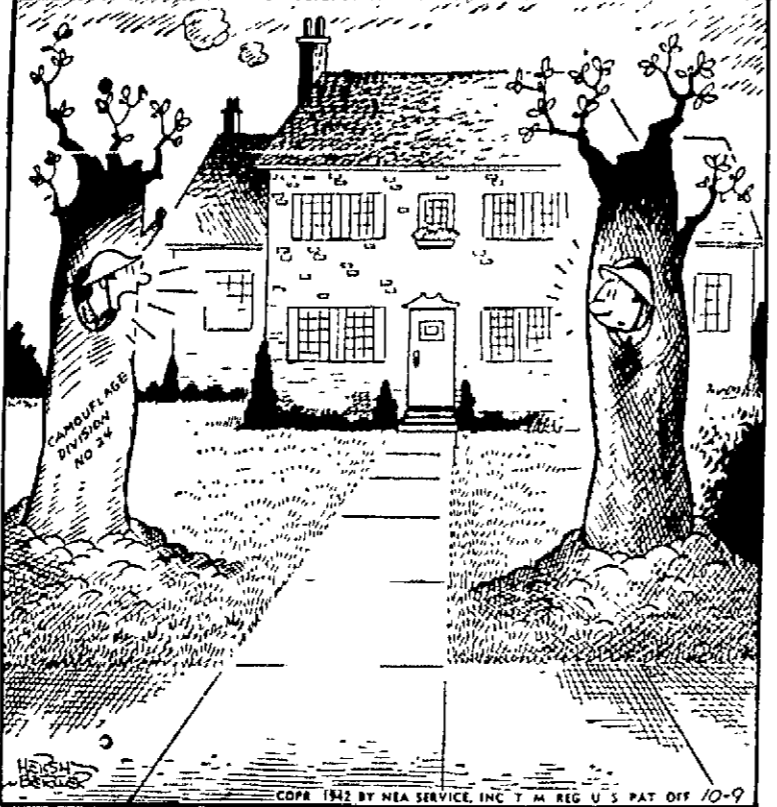
Guthrie also has taken an active part in the college athletic program and has been elected to the Men's Varsity "B," honorary athletic association.

FIRE PREVENTION WEEK NO AID TO KENTON BLAZES

KENTON, Oct. 9.—With four fires in one week—as many as were reported in Kenton and thruout the entire community during August—Fire Chief Ralph Jones, Thursday declared that "fate is against us." The blazes broke out as this community, together with every other part of the United States, was observing Fire Prevention Week.

The latest fire sent the Kenton department to the home of James Remick, where an exploding kerosene stove Wednesday evening, threw flaming fuel thruout the small cottage house. Remick was preparing his evening meal when the explosion occurred, but was unhurt. When firemen arrived, the interior of the house was a blazing inferno. All of the furniture was destroyed and the building gutted. Chief Jones estimated the loss at \$600 to the home and contents.
